





A Lexington man accused of committing a string of rapes and burglaries around the University of Kentucky campus has pleaded not guilty to the charges Monday in Fayette District Court.

Aarion Lamon Johnson, 19, of 528 Withrow Way, is charged with raping four women and burglarizing their homes in the last six months, police said.

According to Lexington police reports, Johnson admitted to breaking into each woman's home, raping and beating her and then stealing items. Twice, Johnson said, he used a knife in an assault, the police reports said. Johnson was arrested two hours after a woman was raped on the 600 block of Breckinridge Street on Friday, police said.

The other attacks happened Nov. 26 in the 500 block of Pemberton Avenue, Feb. 17 in the 200 block of Virginia Avenue, and May 13 in the 100 block of Gatte Avenue.

Johnson was being kept at the Fayette County Detention Center in lieu of an 390,000 full cash bond. He is scheduled to return to court June 22. Police said similarities between the attacks led them to think that one person was responsible for all four incidents. Each victim was in her late teens or early 20s and each was beaten, police reports said.




