Dear Sir:

Please note my letter to Local Attorney Pollard of April 2nd and his reply of March 10th relative to right-of-way not yet secured thru a tract of land in Breathitt County, the title to which is in the Otto Germer heirs.

It is desirable that we secure deed for the right-of-way, and I would suggest that if practicable, an agreement be reached with the Trustee of the heirs whereby we would pay a nominal consideration for the land taken and enter an agreed condemnation suit to secure deed from the Court.

I would be obliged, therefore, if you will authorize Mr. Pollard to proceed with such a course. He can use the description given in the deed which was sent him with my letter of April 2nd in preparing petition in the case.
