

# Warm Weather Inside, Too!

This weeks "Mailbox brings a renewal of the old compant about the overabundance of heat in some of the buildings on campus. Most of the gripes have centered about the library, which more than once has been likened unto a crematory.

A talk with Mr. E. B. Farris, UK's chief engineer, brought out some interesting facts about the University's heating systems. The temperature in the library is kept higher than in most other buildings because of the companist of those who work there all day.

It seems there are other factors to be considered besides thermometer readings. The residual heat of buildings varies and can cause a change in temperature.
