The Faculty convened at the call of the President, at 12:30 p.m. Upon roll-call the following gentlemen were noted as absent:- Messrs. Bennett, Clay, and Miller. Major Helveti had been excused from attendance upon this meeting.

Time of meeting fixed. On motion of Mr. W.H.Patterson it was resolved to hold the regular meetings of the Faculty on the Friday following the first Monday in each month. It was further resolved to meet at 8:15 a.m.

Catalog Committee.

On motion of Mr. Nelson a Committee was appointed on preparation and arrangement of the Catalog for 1893-4. The Committee consists of Messrs. Garman, Keville, and White. By the terms of the motion the Committee is to act with the President.

Committee on Standing Committees.

On motion of Mr. Nelson a Committee was appointed to consider what standing Committees it is advisable to have to simplify and expedite the work of the faculty. This Committee consists of Messrs. Nelson, Castle, Mathews.

Upon resolution the Faculty recommended that the Catalog Committee have the catalog ready for distribution by the close of the Collegiate year.

Petition from Literary Societies to hold Primary Oratorical Contest. The Sec'y read a petition from representatives of the Literary Societies of the College, (No. 6, file B) asking leave to hold a primary oratorical contest to determine who should represent the College in the coming State Inter-collegiate Contest, and further asking that the second-best orator be allowed to represent the College in the Chautauque contest; and that the Committee previously appointed from the Faculty to take the whole matter of oratorical

Contests under consideration, be the judges
on the occasion of the primary contest.
The petition was referred to the Committee
on Oratorical Contests, with full power to
act.

Changes of schedule re A motion was carried to refer all changes
and Catalog of the schedules in the various Courses
Com. of study to the Catalog Committee.

Dr. Kastle reported the recommendations
of the Committee on ^{method of} Determination of Col-
leg. Honors. (No. 7, file B) This Committee

Report of Com. recommended that the President appoint a
Method of deter- committee, representing the various Departments,
mining Coll. Honors. to whose chairman the Faculty should severally
report the half yearly marks of the candidates
for graduation, with such recommendations
as were fit; and that from these marks
and recommendations the Committee should
decide the honors. The report of the committee
was adopted, and the President appointed Means,
R. N. Roark, J. B. White, J. P. Nelson, T. P. Anderson,
C. H. Mathews, and J. H. Neville. *Adjourned,*
