

#### HISTORY

OF

#### Catholic Church in Lexington

The Lexington Catholic Mission began with the journey of Fathers Badin and Barrieres made on foot from Limestone on the Ohio River to Lexington, towards the close of November of the year 1793. "On the first Sunday of Advent," says Dr. Spalding, "M. Badin said Mass in the house of Denis McCarthy, an Irish Catholic, then a clerk in the commercial house of Colonel Moyland, a brother of the bishop of Cork." For a year and a half afterwards Father Badin's headquarters were at a place in Scott county less than

twenty miles from Lexington, where he attended the small number of Catholics then residing there. Up to the year 1800, he was accustomed to say Mass in the house of Thomas Tibbats, his congregation comprising the members of not more than a half dozen families.

In the year 1801, Father John Thayer contracted for the purchase of a lot "adjoining the Baptist graveyard," upon which stood an old log house, the second built in Lexington, which was from that time used as a chapel. This property was deeded to Rev. S. T. Badin, by Samuel Ayres and Jane McNair, on the 20th of November, 1804, in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars.

The feast of St. Patrick in 1810 was made by Father Badin the

occasion of the opening of subscription lists for the erection of a new church in Lexington. More than three hundred dollars were subscribed on the spot and the amount was soon increased to more than ten times that sum. Protestants subscribed as liberally as Catholics. Among the former may be mentioned Captain Nathaniel Hart and Col. Joe Daviess.

It is to be regretted that of the considerable number of Catholic residents of Lexington between the years 1800 and 1815, that so few of their names are known. Up to the year 1825 we read of Thomas Tibbats, Patrick Geoghegan, whose wife was Elizabeth Findston; Samuel Hickey, father of Judge Thomas Hickey; Thomas and Berlinda Hardy Worland, from Scott county; Jeremiah Murphy; Mrs. Eliza Wirt; William Stickney; Matthew Alton; William M'Coy, father of Alex. McCoy, and father-in-law of Denis Mulligan, one of the most influential citizens of Lexington; Mrs. Tigarde; Cornelius Coyle, one of whose grandsons was the late Judge Walton (Cleary, of Lexington, and Stephen Giron. Major John H. Hanley and his family resided at some distance from Lexington, but were reckoned among the members of the congregation.



Major Hanley was held in high esteem in all Eastern Kentucky. Patrick Geoghegan and his wife were long identified with the Catholic history of Lexington, as were also their children at a later day.

The church of St. Peter was opened and dedicated on the 19th of May, 1812, though the deed for the lot upon which it was built—executed in favor of Rev. S. T. Badin by Robert and Ann Todd for the stated consideration of \$312—bears date July 13th, 1813. The building was of brick, Gothic in style and stood upon the ground of the old Catholic Cemetery of Third street. The church was visited, possibly not over twice a month, by Fathers Badin and Angier. This was continued until about the year 1817, when Father

Angier was removed from the mission, and succeeded by Rev. S. H. Montgomery, O. S. D., who for a short time, and with occasional assistance from Father Badin, and from his own associates of St. Rose, managed to serve both the congregation in Scott county and that in Lexington. He was soon afterwards relieved altogether of the care of the Lexington church, by the appointment of Rev. Wm. T. Willett, O. T. D., who served it alone until disabled by sickness in 1823, when Rev. Samuel H. Montgomery, O. S. D., was again sent to his assistance. Father W. T. Willett is represented by Dr. Spalding as a man "as remarkable for his talents as he was for his years. He won the hearts of all who knew him." He fell a victim to consumption on the 9th day of May, 1824, and his remains are interred in the new Catholic Cemetery at Lexington. other priests of those early days are buried here also, the Rev. John McCormick, and Rev. Wm. Morgan, a native of Ireland, and a convert to the Catholic faith, who died at the residence of Major John Hanley in November, 1840.

In 1836, Father Edward McMahon undertook the serious task of building a new church. Finding it impossible to raise the necessary funds at home, where the Catholic people were not able to subscribe the full amount, he went to New Orleans to collect, and is said to have realized the sum of \$5,000. Returning in 1837, he erected the present St. Peters, which was opened for Divine service and dedicated by Right Rev. Dr. Chabrat on the 3d day of December, 1837.

The list of pastors of St. Peter's Church, Lexington, between the years 1824 and 1864 includes the following names: Rev. Guy Ignatius Chabrat, for the year 1825; Rev. Francis P. Henrick, for part of the year 1826; Rev. George A. M. Elder, from 1826 to 1830; Rev. Edward McMahon, from 1830 to 1835; Rev. John McGill, from 1835 to 1836; Rev. Edward McHahon, for 1837; Rev. M. J. Spalding until September, 1838; Revs. Edward and Abraham McMahon and John Joyce, from 1839 to 1849; Rev. John Maguire, from 1849 to 1853; and from that date to 1864, Rev. Francis F. Di Maria, S. J. Rev. Peter McMahon, Rev. H. G. Allen, Rev. Joseph Brogard, and Rev. Peter Perry.

In 1864, the Rev. John Henry Bekkers became pastor and re-

solved to build another and a larger church. The work was begun in 1865, and the corner-stone of St. Paul's was laid by Right Rev. George A. Carroll, bishop of Covington, on the 12th of November of that year. The church being finished was dedicated October 18, 1868. It should be stated that when Father Bekkers arrived in Lexington he found subscriptions awaiting him in the hands of Mr. Denis Mulligan amounting to the sum of nine thousand dollars. This amount was at once devoted to the purchase of the lots on Short street upon which the church of St. Paul's now stands, together with an old but substantial and roomy dwelling house attached, afterwards used as a pastoral residence, and formerly owned and occupied by Robert S. Todd, the father of Mrs. Abraham Lincoln. Some say that Mrs. President Lincoln was born in this house; others, that she only passed in it the years of her girlhood.

Father Bekkers died in February, 1887, and was succeeded by Rev. Ferd. Brossart, who improved St. Peter's at a cost of \$3,000, and built the present excellent Pastoral residence. In 1888, Father Brossart was appointed Vicar General of the diocese of Covington, in which city he has since resided.

Rev. James P. Barry on August 13, 1888, came to Lexington as Pastor of St. Paul's, and in 1889 became its first Irremovable Rector in accordance with the decree of the Third Plenary Council of Baltimore.
