The most famous Orator of Greece; The Son of a Blacksmith, He oppos'd Phillip King of Macedon, & Alexander y^e Great after him, But — being demanded of the Athenians by Antipater, y^e successor of Alexander, He retir'd into y^e Island Celauria, where Archas was sent to apprehend Him, but he to prevent it suck'd the Poyson which he kept in a Quill for that purpose, and so Dyed, Aged 62 Years, — and about 322 Years before the Birth of our Saviour ☺

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
