Section 3117, Ky. Statutes. The Mayor, on the first Monday in April of each year, shall receive such proof as may be offered to him by sworn statement, as may enable him to determine the daily newspaper having the largest bona fide circulation in the city, and the newspaper having such circulation shall be selected and known as the official newspaper of the city.
