My Dear Wife,

Horses and all around here safe yesterday about this time. Kiwi & Planet could not get a car for St Louis till this morning at 7 a m when they went safely. I took the Bansku to the Race Course here ~~this morning~~ last night, arriving at 8.30. Slept on the straw in the stable loft - Arranged with Paul to train & run her in the stake next Thursday for \$500 if she wins, nothing if beaten - and I start at 5.45 this evening for St Louis. I think Paul will come nearer running Bansku right without me, than Cadwallader would order, the others. If God will, I will write you, day of arrival at St Louis to-morrow evening or Sunday - I am very much fatigued, but better than I fear I should be - I hope all is well at home, including the children at Concord. If Bansku can win here, she will sell I think easily for \$5000. We must hope for the best. I saw Henry Hart here yesterday - he went home last evening - I will keep my trunk at his house - Write to me at St Louis, Care of H Clay Hart - 2727 Locust Street - Victory & Peter on the track (hanowed 2 or 3 times a week.)
