Line up, ladies and gentlemen, and meet Mr. Adalph F. Rupp, who is stockly built, does not wear glasses, has straight hair and the desire to develop winning basketball teams at the University of Kentucky. Among the few things we know about Mr. Rupp is that he is not hasty in his settions. When wired the terms and invitation to become coach at Kentucky by the University athletic council in session Tuesday afternoon, Mr. Rupp requested that he be allowed until Wednesday noon before making his decision.
