The 17,987 students who preregistered for the spring semester is an increase of 800 over the figures for the 1979 spring semester, according to Dexter. Total enrollment figures for the spring semester will not be available until the Registrar's office determines how many of the students who register actually remain on campus.



Withdraw from classes early to receive larger tuition refunds

Students who miss UK's three dead-lines for withdrawing from classes or college will also miss their chance to collect refunds, which decrease in amounts as the semester progresses. Requests for refunds must be processed on or before these dates — Jan. 15, the day before classes begin, Jan. 15, the day before classes begin, Jan. 12, the last day to enter an organized class; and March? 4, the last day to drop a course. "If you plan to meet the dead-line for a refund, then you should initiate your schedule change in good time," said George Dexter, associating registration and advising. initiate your schedule chang time," said George Dexter, registrar for registration and

After decreasing their class hours, these students need their fees reassessed to receive a refund and should go to the Registrar's table in the Stu-

dent Center Ballroom. Bring identification and the add-drop slip to prove the transaction took place.

Even if students don't attend classes and withdraw later, the tuition refund drops to 80 percent after the Jan. 15 deadline.

"Jan. 22 will be the last day to witheraw from a class and receive an 80 percent refund; after that time, and up until March 7, students will be able to receive 50 percent refunds for fees paid on classes dropped." Dexter said.
