Intramural Injuries

Plans are underway to find a solution to the problem of adequate protection for students participating in intramural sports. Such action is long overdute. The Physical education department has never carried insurance to cover students taking part in intramural competition. Of course, students enter such play of their own free will and therefore have been assumed to take the responsibility themselves in case of injury.

But this was a little too much. There has been no other instance as serious as this one. It was a fine display of loyalty and the right sort of spirit on the part of the fratternities to shoulder the responsibility for Jin's hill voluntarily. To date they have raised \$1,260.57. It is also commendable that students themselves have taken the initiative in such a situation and the University is backing them 100 percent.

A committee has been appointed by Dr. Donovan to investigate the possibilities of getting group insurance or other plan to take care of intramural players, or perhaps even a campuswide program of accident insurance for all. 
