The students so petitioning are Charles J. A. Kephart, J. S. Jackson, J. B. Johnson and A. W. Coffman. Moved and seconded (Dr. Peter) that no leave of absence be granted them, since the Faculty at a previous meeting had forbidden the students to join the State Guards. Carried.
