There are fol national fraternities on the roll of
the National Interfraternity Conference, and
there are hundreds of, local Greek-letter organizations, as well as scores of sectional fraternities.
The top 75 fraternities in America have approximately 2,300 chapters located at some 200
colleges and universities throughout the 48 states
and Canada. The number of fraternal organizations on individual campuses range from 46 to
none, and total membership of the top 75 Greekletter organizations is over 840,000.

From these figures, we may conclude that the
fraternity system is well established in the colleges scene.
