Chemistry experiment evacuates buildings

Experiments involving a chemical added to natural gas to give it an odor caused the evacuations of four campus buildings yesterday.

The smell of mercaptan, which makes natural gas smell like rotten eggs, was reported from Central Campus buildings such as Patterson Office Tower, sald Lisa Smith, communications manager with Columbia Gas.

UK spokesman Ralph Derickson sid the Main Building, Patterson Office Tower, Mechanical Engineering Building and Miller Hall were evacuated just after 5 pm., but no injuries were reported.

UK employee hit and killed on Limestone

A UK Chandler Medical Center employee was struck and killed while crossing South Limestone Street last might. Skypax-old male, whose name has not been released pending notification of his family, was crossing Limestone by Leader Avenue at 7 p.m. when a Honda Civic driven by Justin Bryant, 22, of Lexington, hit him, according to a Lexington Police report. It could not be confirmed if Bryant is a UK student.

ren, 50, of Lexington, which struck and killed him, according to the report.

He was transported to the medical center where he was pronounced dead at 7:10 pm.

Sgt. Paul Simms with the Lexington Police Department Accident Reconstruction Unit said the man was not using the cross-walk. It was not raining when the man crossed the street and alcohol was not a factor in the crash, Simms said.

Jolice are ruling the fatality an accident, and no charges are being filed against Wearren or Bryant.

Rape reported in Kirwan III

A woman reported being raped in Kirwan III early Saturday morning, according to UK Police.

According to the report, the victim is not a UK student, but the person accused of assaulting her — an acquaintance — is a UK student. His name and the victim's age have not been released.

A nurse at Baptist East Hospital in Louisville contacted UK Police at 10:30 p.m. Saturday to report the rape, which occurred at 4 a.m.

It is not known if drugs or alcohol were a factor.

Capt. Paul Grant with the UK Police said the investigation is ongoing and no arrests had been made. The police declined to release any further details.



Attack the deadliest since Iraq elections

BACHDAD, Irnq — Insurgents unleashed their most violent attacks in Irna; since the country's elections Monday, killing 15 people in mortar and suicide attacks in the northern city of Mosul and 15 more in a car bombing near a police station northeast of Baghdad.

Turmoil reasserted tiself as a new batch of election returns indicated that a Kurdish coalition racked up more than 1 million votes in two northern provinces.

The strength of the Kurdish turnout, with one remaining Kurdish province yet to report, indicated that a coalition put together by Prime Minister Ayad Allawi, a Shilte Muslim, will come in third behind the Shilte coalition of Grand Ayatoliah Ali Sistani and the united Kurdish front, diminishing Allawi's chances to retain a leading role in the government.

Results also appeare, the Sunni majority central region of the country that includes Samara and Tikrit, home of Saddam Hussein's extended clan.

Monday's attacks broke a relative full in violence since the Jan. 30 elections and might have been an indication that the insurgency is trying to reassert itself after millions of voters defied demands for an election boycott.

As has become usual in recent months, Iraqi police and recruits bore the brunt of the attacks.

In Mosul, a man carrying a bomb penetrated a hospital zone where police was staying. The explosion killed him and 12 police officers. Four others were wounded.

Last week, the Office of Student Affairs released an advisory about three recent date rapes that occurred with work of the students. The advisory warned students to be aware of the possibility of date rape and gave detailed information about drugs used in date rapes.

Two days after the advisory was released, a rape took place in a dorm room, UK Police said.

The assault, which occurred in Kirwan III at 4 a.m., was a date rape, UK police "It certainly is terrible"

"It certainly is terrible news that another case has happened, and it just reinferces that we need to devery possible thing we can to prevent these cases from own," said Carol Jordan, director of the Center for Research on Violence Against Women at UK.

Acquaintance rape, also known as "date rape," is a rape that occurs between peole who know nas "date rape, it is the most common form of

rape.

Figures collected by the Lexington Police Department in 2001 listed 55 percent of rapes as occurring between rapes in 1900 listed 55 percent of the rapes were between people who had met the same day. Police also said that in 2001, the victim and the attacker did not know each other in 1225 percent of rapes. The remainder of rapes occurred between people who are relationship or between family members.

According to Lexington police, 26 percent of rapes involved the use of drugs, including date-rape drugs or their medications that can interact with alcohol.

In a UK's survey of 1.010 women on campus, 125 percent of the rapes involved the use of alcohol.





Soon the acquisition of this creature became all-consuming. I spent every day scan-



20 status.


According to UK's current three-year strategic plan for obtaining top-20 status, three of its six goals cannot be reached without focusing on

public and private universi-ties, Diedrichs said. Of public universities, UK is No. 31 on the association's list, based on number of books and number of employees, Diedrichs said. U.S. News & World Re-

port's 2005 list of "America's Best Colleges" lists Kentucky as having more than five mil-lion books. That puts UK al-most exactly in the middle of the list of its benchmarks, with the University of Illinois



and UCLA topping the list.

UK falls lower on the list for number of journal or periodical subscriptions.

The quickest way to move up the rankings would basically be to buy more books, she said.

But there are other factors in improving libraries in the interest of students.

"There's no measurement credit for that, but it helps students," she said.

Media consolidation leads to true indecent exposure

This week marks the anniversary of an extremely important event in American politics: The appearance of a human nipple on television for two and a half seconds.

Janet Jackson's infamous "wardrobe malfunction" infuriated traditionalist parents nationwide, while conservative pundits and self-proclaimed "family values" defenders accused the media of thrusting indecency in America's face.

They said it was terrible that children may have seen a nipple during TV's most-watched event, the Super Bowl. And then they played the now-blurred clip thousands of times, just in case any kid who didn't see it the first time would now.

The result of "Nipplegate" was to otheir remote controls event and family groups started to clamp for the PCC to impose huge fines for any "indecency" sent over the airwayes.

And they succeeded The FCC imposed more than \$7.7 million in fines last year, including \$550,000 for the nipple.

Now children are safe from indecency — unless they live in a household that has cable TV, satellite radio, the

Now children are safe from indecency — unless they live in a household that has cable TV, satellite radio, the Internet, a DVD player, a video game system or a father with a subscription to Playboy.

Meanwhile, media consolidation looms large, while America is too distracted by nipples and Howard Stern to care.

The lack of inescapability of sex and violence on network TV is really the outgrowth of consolidation — fewer and fewer companies own more of the media — which is a problem for all Americans, not just those who dread the possibility of seeing a nipple or hearing a curse word.

Radio is arguably more monolithically controlled than TV: Music stations play disgustingly few songs, and the political spectrum of talk-radio hosts ranges from conservative.

None of this is good for Americans, except for the oligarchy of media owners.

But the FCC cares a lot less about consolidation than it does about the Super Bowl halftime show.

In 2003, the FCC voted to raise the cap on ownership—which limits the percentage of American households that any given broadcaster can reach—from 35 percent and the superior of the

Over the last three seasons, Smith's Cats have dominated the Southeastern Conference. In 2003, the Cats delivered only the third undefeated SEC season since 1856. Smith's Cats have rolled off seven straight victories over the Gators, including that 70-55 (not even that close) beatdown UK gave No. 1 (for a day) Florida in 2003. has given UK a stretch of inparalleled success—he's won 43 of his 46 SEC games—Donovan has encountered some turmoil of his own in Gainesville.
