SYNOPSIS OF CONTENT: the king speaks of his mother's death and of his decision to impose upon himself (and the court) a six-month period of mourning. He urges the duke to act accordingly.

1) the king's signature - Yo el Rey. The letter itself was written by Andrés de Otamendi, secretary to the king
