Re: Bowling Alley Checkup

On my understanding that a contract has been made between the Company and Steve Benedict and John Rupe for rent and operation of the Bowling Alley, I have made the following notes for your consideration and for my department as it applies to maintenance and repair.

1. Alleys

Clean and apply one coat mineralastic  
Sand and varnish gutters  
Repair No. 3 pin rack

2. Bowling Balls

31 balls turned over to T. J. Little which consisted of the following:

12 std. balls reconditioned  
8 std. balls purchased from Mrs. Cantrill  
10 std. balls in good condition  
1 small ball in good condition

At present:

On hand - std. balls	29
On hand - 1 small ball	
Usable balls	<u>17</u>
No. rejected by Benedict and Rupe	12
No. new balls requisitioned - per Benedict and Rupe	13

Per Benedict and Rupe there are at least 6 balls presently usable that are out-size and very infrequently used.
