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COMMERCIAL FEEDS IN KENTUCKY IN 1943 By J. D. TURNER, STACY B. RANDLE, W. G. TERRELL and J. J. ROSE

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The tonnage of commercial feeds sold in Kentucky in 1943, about 630,438 tons, as estimated from the number of guaranty tax tags issued, showed an increase of 47.7 percent over 1942, the largest tonnage in the history of the feed business in the state. About 33.7 percent of the tonnage was straight byproduct feed, 18.3 percent dairy feed, 6.9 percent hog feed, 33 percent poultry feed, and the balance of a miscellaneous nature. Of the total tonnage estimated used in Kentucky for the year, 410,691 tons were special-purpose feeds of which 115,765 tons were dairy feed, 207,540 tons were poultry feed, 18,100 tons were horse and mule feed, and 43,715 tons were hog feed. A summary of estimated sales by class of feed, in tonnage, is given in Table 1.

FEED CONTROL IN THE EMERGENCY

The war economy program for food in Kentucky brought many hard and complex problems to both the feed industry and the feed control department. With it all, the progress was highly satisfactory, as was evidenced by the large increase of livestock in the state and the sale of over 630,000 tons of commercial feeding stuffs this year. Increase in the number of livestock in fact outstripped available supplies of feed. The year 1943 closed under considerable confusion and 1944 entered without an orderly adjustment of available supply to the livestock.

Since livestock increased faster than feed production, manufacturers and feeders were forced to make many substitutions in feed materials and in feeding practices. This condition presented the problem of determining how little animal protein and how much plant protein can be economically used in a ration for hogs and poultry. It had been the general conclusion and practice that poultry should have at least 20 percent and hogs 20 to 25 percent animal protein, and commercial feed rations were made on this basis. However, it was shown by actual practice that greater use can be made of plant protein, especially from the oil meals—particularly soybean oil meal, than was formerly thought. When plant proteins are substituted for animal proteins, more attention must be given to the vitamin and mineral content of the feed, as the protein concentrates from animal sources contain more vitamins and minerals than do the plant protein concentrates.

This was not so much a problem with cattle feeders, because ruminants, by virtue of the nature of their stomach and the microorganisms of the paunch, are able to convert poor protein, and other nutrients as well, into wholesome food nutrients. The young ruminants because of their undeveloped paunches, cannot convert poor protein into good protein and for this reason must be fed a special diet composed of such materials as liquid milk, vitamin carriers, and plant protein.

Because of shortages in certain feed materials at different seasons of the year and more or less general shortage in all feed materials throughout the year, constant changes in feed formulas were necessary to adjust the feeds to materials available at the particular time needed. The Department has permitted manufacturers to make these changes in their feeds without reregistering provided that they requested and gave reason for the change, that the source of nutrients

used was suited to stock to which it was to be fed, and that the general quality of the feed was maintained. In many instances, no doubt, the general quality of feeds varied somewhat from the quality in the original formula, perhaps better in some cases and not quite so good in others, but analyses of inspection samples showed the farmers were well taken care of during this period of the emergency.

Many manufacturers were tempted to adulterate and misbrand feeds because of the prevailing prices, but as a whole, the feed industry cooperated with the Department wholeheartedly and cheats and frauds were kept at a minimum.

GOOD PASTURE IN A FEED PROGRAM

The use of good pasture in the feed program is important to the feeder. The kind of feed a feeder should select is determined very largely by the character of pasture available for his animals. Manufacturers have recognized this fact and as a part of their service to feeders are making feeds to meet the pasture situation. Pasture is the cheapest of all feed and requires the least labor. Pasture, hay, and other forage crops generally speaking supply about 60 percent of all the feed required by most livestock; milk cows get about 76 percent of their feed from these crops, other cattle about 80 percent, horses and mules 67 percent, and sheep 95 percent. Hogs and poultry, on the other hand, get about 95 percent of their feed from grain. It has been possible to meet the feed shortage to a large extent, with the exception of feed for poultry, by the improvement of pastures and growing more and better hay and forages. It has been shown very definitely that the proper use of fertilizer can increase the yield and quality of pasture and hay and that such increases are very desirable and profitable.

BALANCED RATION

One of the most important developments in modern research in animal nutrition is the discovery of the role of vitamins and certain minerals in the growth and development of animals.

A ration is the quantity of feed required by an animal for one day. In formulating a feed ration, it is essential that it provide the necessary nutrients for maintenance and reproduction. A balanced ration is one which furnishes digestible protein, carbohydrates, and fats, and the right kind of minerals and vitamins in such amounts and proportions as are necessary to nourish the animal for a day. The feed or ration must meet the following conditions to produce the best results: (1) The ration must contain sufficient digestible, com-

plete protein and digestible energy-producing substances in right proportions to meet the needs of the animal; (2) it must contain the proper amount of indigestible, fibrous material, such as is found in the fibrous or woody parts of plants; (3) it must contain the right kind of minerals in available forms in sufficient amounts; (4) it must contain the necessary vitamins in adequate amounts; and (5) it must be free from injurious substances such as poisons (especially cumulative poison), disease germs, or anything that produces mechanical injury.

FEEDER'S GUIDE

The feeder has several aids to guide him in selecting a commercial feed. He should never buy one that is not registered and labeled with an official guaranty tag. He should read the tag carefully and base his selection on the information in the guaranty rather than on the claims made by the salesmen. If a feed is not labeled, he should refuse to accept it regardless of any claims made for it. He can also safeguard himself by buying from reputable manufacturers who have good records and make good, clean feeds. He should look with suspicion on all yellow-tag feeds, as such feeds contain fillers of little or no feed value. As a general rule, a feed containing a complex vitamin and mineral mixture is to be avoided, because a long list of materials has no particular merit and needed vitamins and minerals usually can be supplied at lower cost in simple materials.

The Feed Control Department constantly makes check analyses of feeds sold in Kentucky. The results are summarized and published with other valuable data on feeds and their use, in bulletins, which are sent free to any one interested. Other publications that should be of interest to feeders and are available to those who desire them, can be obtained from county agricultural agents or by writing to the College of Agriculture and Home Economics, Lexington.

READ THE TAG

The tag should tell the truth. The best information and protection the purchaser of feeds has is the tag and the honesty of the manufacturer. The purchaser should read the tag carefully and study the guaranty. It contains the name and address of the manufacturer and his guaranty. Compare the tag with the record of the manufacturer in the summary of results in the back part of this bulletin. If his record is good, you can be reasonably sure the feed is what it is represented to be on the tag. If his record is bad, then the feed is likely to be poor.

A feeder who buys on price instead of quality, though price is always a factor to be considered, is practicing false economy. A cheap "yellow tag" feed usually is the costliest feed a farmer can buy, because of the small amount and poor quality of the nutrients and the unwholesomeness of the feed.

WHEAT AS A FEED

The value of wheat as a feed ingredient has long been recognized. The feeding value compares favorably with that of corn, oats, barley, and rye. Wheat is higher in protein (ranging from 12.50 to 13.50 percent) than those grains, contains about the same amount of fat as barley and rye, and about the same amount of fiber as corn and rye. It is low in minerals, as most grains are. Wheat is lacking in Vitamin A, a fact to be considered in substituting wheat for yellow corn.

When used as a feed ingredient, except for scratch grains, wheat should be ground coarse and mixed with other suitable ingredients that give bulk to the feed. If ground fine and fed alone or mixed in large amount with other fine-ground, compact feed it may be hard to digest. If fed to poultry, it may form a cake or crust on the beaks and walls of the mouths, and when fed to stock it may form a mass or cake in the stomach and cause indigestion and possibly death.

Feeders should be cautious in feeding wheat and should follow these rules: (1) grind wheat coarse; (2) do not feed it by itself; (3) do not mix fine-ground wheat in large proportions with other fine-ground, heavy, compact materials. If a large amount of wheat is used, mix it with materials that give fluffiness and bulk to the feed. The amount of wheat that can be fed without causing trouble depends more or less on the texture of the mixture.

FEEDS SUSPECTED OF POISONING STOCK

During the year numerous samples of various kinds of feed suspected of poisoning stock were sent to the Department. Careful examination of these showed, in most cases, that the feed was in good condition, sound, free of off-odors, and of good quality. Many of the samples were fed to chicks or rats as the sole diet, and the experimental animals receiving them were in normal, healthy condition at the end of the feeding period.

A large excess of salt was found in two samples of poultry mash which, it was reported, killed a number of chickens, and one sample of feed which was reported to have killed most of a large flock of small chickens contained Paris green. In each case it appeared that these substances were present by accident.

It is important that we know the nature of the problem before undertaking an analysis. We suggest consulting the county agent or veterinarian first and if an analysis seems desirable, the nature of the problem should be explained and pertinent facts stated, when the sample is sent.

EXPLANATION OF TERMS USED IN ANALYSIS OF FEEDS

Protein designates the principal nitrogen compounds of a feed. Animals use protein to build and repair tissues. However, when carbohydrates and fats are deficient in the diet, protein may be used to produce heat and energy, but this is undesirable both physiologically and economically. Plants build protein from water, nitrogen compounds and certain minerals of the soil, and carbon dioxide of the air. Protein from animal sources such as milk, meat scraps, and tankage, is plant protein which has been partly broken down by the digestive processes of the animal and reconstructed into the kind of protein specific for the animal tissue. The nutritional values of proteins differ greatly; therefore, it is well to select feeds which contain several ingredients and therefore a variety of proteins. Proteins derived from animal sources, such as milk, meat and meat byproducts, are very desirable for poultry, hogs, dogs, and young animals of all kinds. Animal proteins are not so necessary for mature animals, especially the ruminants because these have the power to utilize other proteins.

Fat is the ether soluble nutrient in a feed and consists chiefly of fats and oils but a small percentage of waxes, resins, and coloring matter may be included. Fats can be deposited in the body tissues as such, or can be burned in the body to furnish heat and energy. The energy value of fat is high, being 2.25 times that of the nitrogen-free extract.

Fiber is the woody portion or structural part of plants. It consists mainly of cellulose, which has little feed value because of its low digestibility. Generally seeds and grains contain very little fiber, while the protecting hulls and husks and the supporting stems, are high in this constituent. Excessive fiber in a feed indicates that the percentage of essential nutrients is low and that their digestibility is impaired.

Water is present in all feeds. It adds nothing to their value because animals receive their main supply of water from other

sources. Water reduces the value of a feed by decreasing the percentages of the other nutrients, and much water lowers the keeping

quality of the feed.

Ash is the mineral matter or residue of a feed which remains after complete burning. The ash of vegetable materials contains minerals which the plant has taken from the soil. Most of these elements are essential in the proper nutrition of an animal. The ash from different plants, and from different parts of the same plant, varies in amount and feeding value. The minerals most commonly deficient in stock feeds are calcium and phosphorus. An excessive amount of ash in a feed usually means the presence of inert matter, such as dirt or sand.

Nitrogen-free extract. In making the usual chemical analysis of a feed, the chemist determines the percentages of protein, fat, fiber, ash, and water and terms the remainder nitrogen-free extract. It is composed chiefly of starches, sugars, and pentosans which are easily digestible. Like fat, nitrogen-free extract in the diet of an animal is oxidized to maintain body heat and produce energy for work. can be synthesized by the animal, from nitrogen-free extract.

Vitamins are organic food substances distinct from the more familiar nutrients (proteins, fats, carbohydrates, and minerals) but necessary in nutrition for normal growth and reproduction. Although these substances are required only in very small quantities, some feeds do not contain enough for proper growth and productiveness. ficiency in each vitamin leads to specific disease symptoms usually first manifested by lack of growth. Frequently, the feeder does not suspect a vitamin deficiency because he notices only retarded growth. The typical symptoms usually appear only in the later stages of the disease. When the feeder uses commercial feeds, he should select feeds made by reputable manufacturers whose record for making reliable feeds is good. When he is home-mixing feed, he should select only ingredients of high quality and well-known value.

The vitamins are widely distributed in plant and animal materials commonly fed to livestock and poultry. Green feeds, legumes, and natural green hays are the principal sources of carotene (vitamin A) and riboflavin (vitamin G). All grains except yellow corn have very little vitamin-A activity, but are good sources of the vitamin B complex. Vitamin E is present chiefly in leafy materials, vegetable and animal oils, and the germs of seeds, especially the germ of wheat. No feeds are good sources of Vitamin D, the chief source for farm animals being direct sunlight and fish oils, or their equivalent.

The first principle of avoiding vitamin deficiencies in feeding is the maximum use of high-quality roughages, and direct sunlight. High-quality roughages include green pasture, legume or grass silage, corn silage, leafy and green sun-cured legume hays. Animals that normally consume large quantities of roughage of this sort will not need special vitamin supplements. Poultry and hogs consume more concentrates than roughages and therefore should be given maximum use of green pasture and direct sunlight. However, when these are not available, the animals should be given a liberal amount of milk byproducts and alfalfa leaf meal. The most practical way to supply vitamin D to confined fowls is to use biologically tested fish oil or its equivalent. Irradiated yeast as a source of vitamin D, is valuable. only for four-footed animals.

POISONOUS WEED SEEDS AND FUNGI

Care should be exercised by farmers in feeding materials that are likely to contain poisonous weed seeds and fungi. Stock may be made sick, thrown off of feed, or die from eating them. Besides, if germination of the weed seeds is not prevented by grinding or heating to a high temperature in the manufacturing process, some of them will pass through the animals, germinate, and will introduce weeds, some of which may be noxious, on the premises.

Screenings, screenings waste, and fillers used in "yellow tag" feeds usually contain a large amount of miscellaneous weed seeds, some of which may be poisonous. In addition, these materials contain things which may be deleterious to the health of animals, such as hulls, chaff, joints, elevator dust, sand, and dirt. It is a serious question whether a feeder can afford to risk feeding such material at any price.

Though many weed seeds may cause poisoning, the most dangerous weed seeds and fungi likely to occur in feeds containing screenings, screenings waste, or filler are:

SUMMARY OF RESULTS OF INSPECTION AND ANALYSIS, 1943

The results of analyses of inspection samples of feeds for 1943 showed a wider variation in irregularities in both the chemical and microscopical analyses than in previous years. This was due mainly to shortages of feed materials at certain seasons, necessitating the substitution of other feed materials of similar nature not listed in the original formulas. It has been the custom of the Department, when requested and when proper explanation is given, to permit such changes of ingredients to be made in the formulas during the emergency. These changes have been contingent upon the manufacturer maintaining the same chemical standards of quality in his feeds. Only such irregularities, therefore, of a flagrant nature and those not due to the interchange of ingredients of like nature, are reported in this summary of analytical results.
