LIVE STOCK- 5 BROOD SOWS, RAISING 2 LITTERS, SOLD AVERAGING 200 POUNDS-10 BEEF COWS; CALVES GROWING INTO BABY BEEF; ONE PURE BRED BULL, ONE MILK COW, 25 EWES & THEIR LAMBS.
