

## Keeping calm eases add/drop

Administrator says procedure 'not the end of the world'

Tomorrow the adventure begins, as UK students get the chance to give their schedules the fine tuning they may need after preregistration.

Centralized add/drop will begin Tuesday, morning at 10 a.m. and will run through 6 p.m. at Memorial Coliseum. Students can add classes through January 21 and have until March 6 to drop a class.

Departments in the College of Arts & Sciences will remain in the Coliseum until Wednesday.

No 2 pencils are helpful, but Marjey McQuilkin, assistant registrar for student records and services, suggests that students also "stay calm" during add/drop. "Students just have to try to remember that this is not that bad and is not the end of the world," she said.

Despite the horror stories students often associate with add/drop, it's really "not that bad," McQuilkin said.

"Often students go in there thinking add/drop is going to take five hours and sometimes they walk out five minutes later with everything they wanted," she said.

"We don't hear the success stories, we only hear the horror stories," she said.

Ann Fister, advising conference director, said the best way a student can prepare for add/drop is by developing a plan with alternative classes in case a particular section or class is closed.

"Students should go in prepared to spend some time, take it leisurely and not get stressed out over it all," she said.

Because add/drop will stay open until 6 this semester, McQuilkin said no exceptions would be made for

students needing to enter the Coliseum before their designated time. She said students will be able to enter the Coliseum after their time slot has passed, but not before.

Students eligible to participate in tomorrow's centralized add/drop are those who preregistered and paid their \$50 confirmation fee.

Students receive information sheets when they enter the Coliseum, giving them step-by-step directions and a map showing where the departments are located.

Once students have completed add/drop, they must then turn their add/drop slips in to their college dean.

McQuilkin said a way in which long lines can be avoided at add/drop may be to avoid the "unnecessary shopping around."

"Sometimes a student will have a Math 123 class, section 22 at 9 a.m.

and they will want to change it to section 23 at 11 p.m.," she said.

In addition, McQuilkin said that students should remember to drop a class if they attempt to add or change class sections. "We can't read minds and we don't have a machine that stops and says when a student has two different sections of the same class," she said.

Students who must late register will have to obtain a course request form and have it approved by their dean's office, Fister said. There is a \$20 late registration fee.

During late registration, which runs from Wednesday through Jan. 21, students must go to the individual departments of the classes in which they want to enroll. All students who late register must turn in their completed course request forms outside 204 Miller Hall.

## UK offices will remain open longer

Jan. 28 deadline for fees payment

A flood of bills and paperwork always accompanies the first weeks of a semester, but many UK offices are extending their hours to help students keep their heads above water.

Although the Student Billings Service is opening at 8:30 a.m. as usual, it will remain open until 6 p.m. on Mondays through Thursdays and until 4:30 p.m. on Fridays from Jan. 13-28. It will also be open from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturdays during these two weeks.

The last day for students to pay their fees in full is Jan. 28. The office will "probably be open longer than 6 that day," said Ben Crutcher, director of student billings.

If students change their enrollment status, they must bring their add/drop slips to the Registrar's Office, 106 Gillis Building, before Jan. 28 to avoid being assessed the wrong fee, said Marjey McQuilkin, assistant registrar for student records and services. That office will be open from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Jan. 15-17 and Jan. 20-21.

If students have already paid their fees in full, they can get their IDs validated from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. in the Student Center Ballroom during the first two weeks of the semester, or from 8:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. in the student billings office, 257 Student Center.

Crutcher said the lines in the ballroom will probably be shorter.

Students who registered late will not be able to pick up their leftover financial aid checks until Jan. 29, Crutcher said.

The University subtracts what students owe from their financial aid checks and then awards the remainder, so students need not worry about their tuition debts, he said.

Students who preregistered can pick up their checks from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. through Jan. 28 in the ballroom, said Sheri Linton, a receptionist in the student financial aid office. After that date, the checks can be picked up in 257 Student Center.

Meal plans can be changed through Jan. 24, but students will have to pay \$25 for the change, said Allen Riemann, director of UK Food Services. The fee must be paid by Jan. 28, he said.

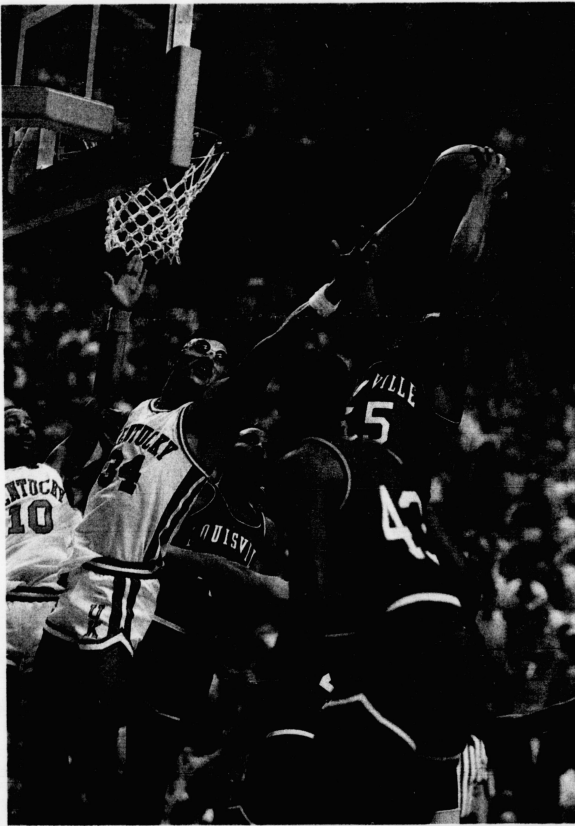
Students who live in residence halls can change their plans in the housing office in the Service Building or in 204 Student Center during the first week of the semester.

Those who live in Greg Page Apartments or off campus can change their meal plans in 200 Student Center during the first week or in the Food Storage Center behind K-Lair Grill the second week, Riemann said.

As long as students have paid their \$100 deposit, their meal cards will be valid through Jan. 28, he said.

Meal plan changes that require a refund are handled through student billings.

Processing of the refund will take three weeks, except for students who receive financial aid, Crutcher said. They will be reimbursed within a week after the billing office is informed of the change.

## Sutton's Christmas full of glad tidings for victorious Cats

At his first press luncheon as Kentucky coach, Eddie Sutton compared his excitement about coaching the Wildcats to a kid's at Christmas — he had to pinch himself to see if he was dreaming.

Sutton was wide awake as his Wildcats won five of their holiday games during his first Christmas season at UK.

First, the Wildcats captured the 33rd University of Kentucky Invitational Tournament by downing East Carolina and Pepperdine by an average of 33 points. They then crashed the boards Dec. 28 to beat Louisville at its own game, 69-64.

Two nights later, UK destroyed lovely Virginia Military Institute 65-55 at Freedom Hall, and then opened its Southeastern Conference schedule by warding off Vanderbilt 80-71 on Jan. 4 in Nashville.

"I think this ball club is getting better," Sutton said after the Louisville game. "They've always played hard, but now they're beginning to grasp what we're trying to do offensively and defensively."

The Wildcats weren't exactly sluggish offensively or defensively during the UKIT.

Spanning the last three minutes of the first half and the first nine of the second, a 39-6 scoring drive by the 30-point favorite Wildcats was enough to put the Cats past East Carolina and into Saturday night's final against Pepperdine.

Going again with its three guards — Roger Harden, James Blackmon and Ed Davender — the Wildcats mounted a similar scoring drive (29-6) beginning the second half which drained the Waves, then a Top 20 team.

Senior Kenny Walker, who scored 40 points in the tournament, was voted the Most Valuable Player, and Blackmon and Davender made the all-tournament team.

"I've always thought you can win a lot of games with three guards," Pepperdine coach Jim Harrick said following the game, "but you can't win the league."

But you can beat U of L.

Even with a shorter lineup, the Wildcats out-rebounded the Cardinals 36 to 24. That, coupled with the dominating play of junior forward Winston Bennett, was enough for UK to take the fifth so-called "Dream Game."

Bennett, who was disappointed after he failed to make the UKIT all-tournament team after two strong performances, scored a career-high 23 points and also had seven rebounds.

Walker's game-high 14 rebounds and Harden's key baskets down the stretch helped the Cats offset Louisville's depth and quickness.

"I look forward to see what everybody has to say about the loss," Bennett, a Louisville native, said after the game.

In its annual game at Freedom Hall, the Wildcats were greeted by more than 14,000 fans at shooting practice the afternoon before the game with VMI. What they saw that night was a Kentucky team play its white bench as it coasted to an easy win and upped its record to 9-1.

"Records really don't mean anything starting this week," Sutton said after the game, about heading into the SEC schedule. "It's tough to start out a conference race on the road because everybody feels they can win the thing."

Had it not been for Walker's 25 points, with a couple of key baskets inside the last five minutes, the Wildcats would have gotten an even bigger scare from Vandy.

The Commodores cut UK's 15-point halftime lead to five three times, before the Wildcats put the game away down the stretch.

"If it hadn't been for some crucial baskets by Kenny Walker, we would have been in trouble," Sutton said, as the Cats upped their record to 1-0 in the conference and 10-4 overall.

Rounding out its four games in eight days, the Wildcats played Auburn, Mississippi and Alabama last week. UK meets Mississippi State Wednesday in Starkville and Florida Saturday in Gainesville.

## Image building

SAB vice president optimistic about Little Kentucky Derby; committee planning trip to Florida

The Student Activities Board's spring schedule is similar to what it has been in the past, but the group's officials say that students can look forward to some changes.

"Our main objective is to continue building a reputable image through the programs that we put on," said Paul Hayden, SAB president.

Hayden said UK needs SAB because it offers students a variety of things to do. "SAB activities can help enhance students' knowledge as well as give them an occasional break from the books."

A highlight of the coming semester is SAB's Little Kentucky Derby, UK's annual spring festival. The organization is already planning events for the April affair.

Hayden said SAB is hoping the festival will be one of the biggest events of the season. "We are giving it a new face," he said. "Basically, we are shortening the number of days from one week to three days. We want to pack these three days with as many activities as possible."

"A lot of time and effort has been put into making the LKD a big success," said David Nickell, SAB vice president. "There is no doubt in my mind that this will be the best LKD at least in the past 10 years."

The concert committee is currently negotiating for an act to perform sometime this semester, said Kakkie Urch, concert committee chairwoman. "We are looking forward to booking a group that is as successful as those in the fall."

SAB has also put together a new movie schedule. This semester movies

will run for six days, instead of the usual two- or three-day period. The visual arts committee is contracting new art exhibitions for the Hasdall Gallery, and the travel committee is planning for a spring break trip to South Padre Island, Fla.

The special activities committee is working on a couple of projects yet to be announced, Hayden said. These projects will add a little flavor to campus life.

SAB has also "just allocated money for a speaker who should be interesting and will draw a big crowd," Hayden said.

He said the organization will be able to contract more speakers and shows with the extra \$1.50 it will receive when the student fee increase goes into effect this fall.

All students are eligible to join an SAB committee, Nickell said. "If a student wants to have a voice in

what happens on campus, then all they have to do is come to the SAB office, 204 Student Center, and fill out an application.

"We want students to sign up for committees because we want to know their ideas," he said, as well as their help coordinating programs.
