No snow now, but UK ready for the worst

Wednesday's warnings of snow did not materialize in Lexington yesterday beyond a light coating of ice, but with two more months of winter ahead and snow forecast for the weekend, severe weather should not be counted out of the forecast.

UK has its own severe winter weather procedures — ranging from closing some University operations to canceling early classes — that it follows in the event the campus and local area are hit with snow or ice.

Joy Burch, vice president for University relations, makes the closing and postponement decisions.

Burch said since some operations of UK, such as the Chandler Medical Center, residence halls and the Physical Plant Division never close, the administration tries to keep classes on schedule as well.

When it does snow...

UK outlined its procedures in memo to faculty and staff.

▼ "Since major units of the University must remain open, the University will make every effort to ensure that all offices remain open and that classes meet as scheduled."

▼ "The cancellation or delay of classes announcements will normally be made by 6 a.m. ... from UK TV cable channel 16 or the UK Infoline at 257-5684."

▼ "Employees who are required to report under Plan B ... must report even under these conditions."

regarding personal safety.

"We're dealing with an older group of people who can make their own decisions on conduct and safety," he said.

If cancellation or delay of classes is imminent, Burch said, after reviewing weather reports and road conditions from UK Police and information concerning local business operations, UK will normally make the announcements by 6 a.m. through local media.

The most up-to-date information can be obtained from UK TV on cable channel 16 or through the UK Infoline at 257-5684.

Even when classes are canceled or delayed and offices closed, certain employees whose jobs are considered essential are required to report under a Plan B. Supervisors develop their own Plan B schedules.

UK closed due to snow Jan. 18, 1994 after 10.2 inches of snow fell in Lexington over the Martin Luther King Jr. holiday.

A state of emergency was declared in Kentucky, and the interstate highways were closed. It was the first time the classes had been called off and most offices closed since 1978.

Burch said the city asked UK to close to help reduce traffic. Most parking lots were also filled with snow, so employees and commuters had no place to park.

He said both the city and UK would be more prepared to handle a snow emergency this year if one occurred because several have occurred since 1994. Burch said prior to the 1994 storm Lexington had not suffered a significant one and many UK and Lexington workers were not used to dealing with all the snow.

Burch said college students should not compare themselves to students in elementary and secondary schools when those schools close.

"We don't have a schedule to make up the days," Burch said.

Students find comfort with UK-VIP, Add/Drop

Having a class canceled is the last thing students want to hear as they relax during the winter break, but because of Add/Drop students get a second chance to fill that gaping schedule hole.

Add/Drop continues this week and gives students who have already registered the opportunity to add or remove classes from their schedule over the phone. But some students want a more personal touch when it comes to changing classes. Tired of frequently being cut off by the automated operator, communications junior Angela Swanson said, "It would be better if we just had a human to talk to."

Still more students seem to find UK-VIP convenient.

"I think it's very convenient to have that option available to use," said Matt Matteson, a psychology junior.

"We're trying to get students a good impression of VIP," said Assistant Registrar Michelle Nordin. "And I think most students have a good impression of the phone system."

Students who registered in November may alter their spring schedule between Jan. 10-11 and 13-22. For students who did not priority register, but still plan to attend spring classes at UK, late registration will run Jan. 15-22. Students registering on these dates will be assessed a \$40 late fee.

Don't let me forget...

Last day to drop a class with a full refund - Jan. 14

Last day to add/drop with UK-VIP - Jan. 22

Need to pay fees - Jan. 29

Last day to drop class without a "W" grade - Feb. 5

Last day to withdraw from a class - March 14

UK-VIP, or University of Kentucky Voice Information Processing Network, is operational Monday through Friday 7 a.m. - 8 p.m., except Jan. 13 and 14 when it will be open 1 - 8 p.m. The number for UK-VIP is 257-7000 or 7-700 if calling on campus.

UK-VIP, first used in fall of 1993, allows students to register by phone. Before the dawn of the computer, students registered at terminals and stood in long lines.

Hearing impaired and other students unable to use the telephone may come to the registrar's office during their registration windows.

If you need help with registration, go to 5 Funkhouser Building or call 257-7173 between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The registrar's office offers several suggestions to help students deal with UK-VIP.

▼ Before dialing, have your desired schedule written out and have the Spring 1997 Schedule of Classes at hand.

▼ If you have a problem accessing UK-VIP, try another phone. Do not use the cordless or cellular phones and do not use automatic busy red... or any type of redial function.

▼ Know your PAC (Personal Access Code) which allows you into the UK-VIP network. If you do not know your PAC, you should go to the registrar's office with a photo ID.

▼ Remember to press the pound key (#) after each entry.



THE Crucible

Miller's play an Oscar contender

Arthur Miller's searing Broadway production about witchcraft, has become a staple of second-year high school English studies since its 1953 release. Sophomores who think they're too cool for this boring literature may be in for a rude awakening.

With the film version hitting the area today, those same students who cringe at cultural experiences will be brought to the startling realization that "This is cool, I am not."

The film, originally slated for a Thanksgiving release, makes its long-awaited Lexington debut with a bang. The sizzling tale of false accusations involving witchcraft and deals with the devil finds a setting in the small puritan town of Salem, Mass., in 1692.

Oscar darlings Winona Ryder and Daniel Day-Lewis star as the accuser and the accused, Abigail Williams and John Proctor, respectively. Their screams are loud, their eyes burn with rage and the confrontations crackle with intensity. They are flat-out good. Even with the stars in top form, the more memorable roles come from the older supporting crew. Paul Scofield as Judge Danforth and Joan Allen as Elizabeth Proctor turn in brilliant performances. Both are coming off Academy Award nominations and both recently earned Golden Globe nominations for their work in *The Crucible*.

Karron Graves, best known for her appearances on "Saturday Night Live," makes an impressive film debut as Mary Warren. Other cast members include veterans Bruce Davison as the deceptive Reverend Parris and Jeffrey Jones as the equally unlikeable Thomas Putnam.

Although Miller originally wrote the play with underlying themes responding to Joseph McCarthy's communist hysteria, the material is timeless and holds up very well among contemporary audiences. The performers rise to the occasion but the true beauty of the film lies in Miller's disturbing, introspective story.

Nicholas Hytner, who brings experience with stage-to-screen adaptations (*The Madness of King George*), directed the film and worked with Miller to write the screenplay. His stylized camera work and

ability to capture "the moment," did wonders in setting the play into motion. *The Crucible*, in every sense, moves like a movie rather than a stage production.

Taking on an emotionally charged piece like this, there is the risk of excess, melodrama and overacting. But the only excess in this film appears when makeup and costume designers go a little too far with the writhing looks by placing inordinate amounts of scum on the teeth of the actors. Besides the film's ability to move me, I really wanted to brush my teeth after seeing Day-Lewis and his hygiene nightmare.

Expect the film to be seen in schools as teaching material and the dentist's office as a scare tactic. Take the family and friends and be one of those who can say "I saw that" when the Oscar nominations are announced next month.

Haskins Rhode Island-bound

Two years ago, he was the player all the fans wanted running the Wildcat offense. Now, Billy Jack Haskins has grown so frustrated with his situation at that he is transferring to the University of Rhode Island.

The fifth-year senior from Paducah Tilghman High School made the decision after new UK head football coach Hal Mumme told Haskins that Tim Couch would be the Cats' starter in the upcoming season. Mumme asked Haskins to move to the H-Back position in UK's new wide-open offensive attack.

"Even after the coaching change I had intended to stay at the University of Kentucky," he said in a prepared statement, "assuming I would be allowed to compete for starting quarterback again."

"Contrary to some of the previous reports, I was never beaten out on the football field nor was my scholarship revoked," he said. "I was simply not allowed to compete for the job. I walked into (Mumme's) office and asked 'Is there a chance I can play quarterback?' He said 'There is none.'

In the offense Mumme brings from Division II Valdosta State, the H-Back position is much like a flanker in that he will run pass routes like a receiver and carry the football like a running back. It means also read defenses and react accordingly.

"I know what Billy Jack Haskins gave great effort and served the University of Kentucky well," Mumme said in a statement released on Jan. 4. "I am sad to see him go and wish him the best at the University of Rhode Island. I hope he will continue to hold a dear spot in his heart for Kentucky as I know the people at UK do for him."

Rhode Island is a Division 1-AA school, which means Haskins will not have to sit out a year after transferring. If he would have transferred to a Division 1-A school, by NCAA regulations, a player must sit out one year.

The Rams, a member of the Yankee Conference, went 4-7 last year.

"It's a good fit for me," he said. "The offense they

run is pro-style. They're pretty balanced."

Haskins also considered Villanova, Delaware, Richmond, Buffalo and Murray State. Murray was eliminated from the running after head coach Houston Nutt left to coach at Boise State.

"I talked to some former coaches, Coach (Bill) Curry, Coach (Elliot) Uzelac, and they helped me with some friends they had in 1-AA ball," he said. "They contacted a few guys they respected and places where they felt I could win."

In his career at UK, Haskins started 18 games, with the Cats registering an 8-10 mark in those games. He initially gained the starter's role in the third game of the 1995 season against Indiana and led UK to two straight wins. UK finished that season with a 4-7 record.

Last year, Haskins completed 95-of-175 passes, with four touchdowns and four interceptions. In 1995, he had a single-season school record for completion percentage by connecting on 93-of-154 for 1,176 yards with four touchdowns and six interceptions.

He also had 1995's Most Inspirational Player, which occurred in the fourth quarter against Tennessee at Commonwealth Stadium.

Playing with a separated shoulder, Haskins ripped off a pinball-like 47-yard touchdown run that gave the Cats a short-lived lead over the Volunteers.

But throughout last season, the state's 1992 Mr. Football found himself under constant pressure from opposing defensive linemen and felt the heat of play-off games.

At the end of the year, Mumme had him to talk about the position change.

"I would have liked to finish my career here (at UK)," he said.

"But I'm not the kind of player that wanted to ride my career out. I played too much and worked too hard to stay at UK as a token."

Haskins started nine games during the 4-7 1996 season. The only games he did not start were a 65-0 romp by eventual national champion Florida in Gainesville and in a 41-14 loss at LSU, the Southeastern Conference Western Division Co-Champions.

He did say that he had no bad feelings toward either UK or Couch, but hasn't spoken to Mumme

since Dec. 3. That was the day in which Mumme had him to talk about the position change.

"I would have liked to finish my career here (at UK)," he said.

"But I'm not the kind of player that wanted to ride my career out. I played too much and worked too hard to stay at UK as a token."

UK signs receiver
Lance Mickelson, a 6-foot-3, 180-pound junior college wide receiver, is Mumme's first scholarship signee.

Mickelson played his junior college football at Snow College in Ephraim, Utah. As a sophomore, he caught 38 passes for 899 yards and 14 touch-downs.

'Purple' rides into Lynagh's

Oodles of southern-fried Grateful Dead wannabe bands have been scampering out of the Southeast like a horde of rabid opossums. Few develop a sound that is unique. Purple Schoolbus is one of them.

Purple Schoolbus is not really a band but an earthy funk orchestra. One unique quality of the band is its technical proficiency which is reflected in its gift for rhythm. They play like Juilliard graduates and blend as if they had been playing together for years. Purple Schoolbus' first live performance was opening for Widespread Panic over two years ago. Since their debut, they have cut two CDs: a self-titled, 10-track album in 1994 and the 11-track *Phoenixia Blind* in 1995.

A seven-player ensemble make up the Purple Schoolbus band, which all play guitars throughout the tunes throughout the album. Two drummers, Todd May and Scott Scala, lay a subtle but solid rhythm foundation for the band. The rhythm section is rounded out by Bernie Taylor on bass, Mark Harris plays tenor and soprano saxophones. Keyboards and harmonica are mastered by Jesse Jennings. Micah Peedin and Kevin Sledge comprise a seamless guitar team.

Purple Schoolbus travels a lyrical route through inner space. All of the band contributes to the lyric writing, even if they aren't necessarily singing. The first track on *Phoenixia Blind*, "All In Your Head," explores the sheer monotony of being human. "Stompin' on Saxes" is the most danceable tune on the album because of its groovy rhythm. "Ride So High" is equally gifted and is one of the better songs on the album. Its lyrics are simple and the music sounds uncomplicated, reflecting the spirit of the song.

"Sparrow Song" has a warm, familiar sound. Listeners can smell this song and visualize a chorus of Hobbit characters seated around a table toasting and singing. "Fool" is another introspective track with an excellent jam in the middle. Second to "Ride So High," "Fool" exemplifies the heart of the Purple Schoolbus style.

"Down On Your Knees" is the most Deadheadish song on the album. The song includes impressive keyboard maneuvers during the chorus.

Nearly all of *Phoenixia Blind*'s tracks run over four minutes. It makes for a long album: a monument to the band's creativity since it produced a 10-track album only a year earlier plus the heavy touring schedule.

Roberts having frustrating year

Before the start of the UK women's basketball season it was a no-brainer as to who would lead the Cats. UK junior forward Shaunda Roberts entered the year as UK's top offensive threat after averaging over 17 points per game last season. She was one of two returning starters from the 1995-96 season. The Toledo, Ohio, native also led last year's squad in minutes played with over 35 minutes a game last year. Now Roberts is getting accustomed to spending time on the bench rather than the floor.

When healthy, Roberts did start early in the season. She missed one game and came off the bench for two games because of an injured back.

The back injury has plagued Roberts' throughout her career, especially this season, though she does not use that as a reason for lack of playing time.

"I don't know what the reason for that (the benching) is," Roberts said. "I don't think it has anything to do with my injury. I think it is just the coach's decision."

Roberts last start came in a Dec. 15 loss to Indiana. She has been off the bench in six consecutive games including Wednesday's 65-54 loss to No. 8 Vanderbilt and may have had her best performance of the season. Roberts went 7-of-8 from the field for a game-high 19 points in 28 minutes of play in the loss to Vandy.

"That's what Shaunda is capable of doing but Shaunda doesn't come out every day and practice and play like that," UK head coach Bernadette Mattox said. "And she doesn't go out and play defense like she's capable of doing."

Mattox stresses bad defense is the reason Roberts is seeing more time on the pine.

"She hasn't played defense," Mattox said. "You gotta do both (offense and defense). A freshman is a freshman. It takes them time to learn, but she's a junior and she's got to know that."

Roberts has no idea whether she will continue to come off the bench but she uses the demotion as a learning experience. "I wouldn't say that it makes me work harder. I just use it as a learning tool," she said. "I really don't know the reason for it but I just have to go with the decision."






