After some spirited discussion the follow-  
ing resolutions were adopted:

Resolved: That J. C. Mays and Paul Timber-  
lake be readmitted into the College and Lewis Mul-  
ligan be retained in it on conditions:

1. That they make a full statement of their con-  
nection with the destruction of property at the Woodlands,

2. That they promptly pay for the injury done  
by them to said property.

3. That they pledge themselves carefully to ob-  
serve hereafter all the regulations of this college.

4. That they be admonished by the President  
before the Faculty and Students in the Chapel for  
wanton destruction of property at the Woodlands  
and for refusing to tell the truth about it.
