# 1988-89 Lady Kats Basketball ENTIUCH

#### Friday, January 6, 1988 Memorial Coliseum, Lexington, Ky., 7:30 p.m.

The Kentucky Lady Kats hope lady luck will smile upon them in 1989 as they open Southeastern Conference play against the highly-regarded Vanderbilt University Lady Commodores in what UK hopes will be its first win of the new year and in conference play. The game is also the SEC opener for Vandy.

The Lady Kats, picked to finish last in the conference in a preseason poll of SEC coaches, finished the 1988 season with an 0-9 SEC record. Vanderbilt, meanwhile, was picked to finish sixth this season. The Lady Commodores finished seventh with a 4-5 record last season, after being picked to finish third.

After losing to Vandy (83-68) in Nashville during the regular season last year, the Lady Kats got even by eliminating the Lady Commodores in 75-67 in the first round of the SEC tournament in March. That gave UK a 9-3 series lead.

However, the Lady Kats are not expected to add to that lop-sided edge tonight. Vanderbilt has recorded only two losses so far this season--to Old Dominion and to Middle Tennessee, the latter which will host UK in a 1 p.m. game on Sunday. In its most recent poll, USA Today lists Vanderbilt No. 21 nationally

Coach Sharon Fanning hopes to prove the preseason polls wrong, but realizes the difficult task her team will face against Vandy. "Vanderbilt has consistently had some of the best talent in the conference," said UK's second-year coach. "Wendy Scholtens was one of the best players last year and everybody on their team can play. They have some

of the best inside players who are very mobile and several of their guards can score from the three-point range."

Kentucky, coming off an upsetting 74-70 loss at Morehead Tuesday night, will face the Commodores with a balanced attack that is led by guards Jodie Whitaker (12.9 ppg) and Kristi Cushenberry (12.2 ppg). Forward Pam Shrum (12.1 ppg, 5.8 rpg) and center Vanessa Foster-Sutton (10.3 pgg, 7.1 rpg) are UK's other double-figure scorers.

Vanderbilt will start 6-4 sophomore center Wendy

Scholtens, who is averaging 22.1 points a game and 9.8 rebounds. Scholtens, the 1988 SEC Freshman Player of the Year, scored 34 points and totaled 21 rebounds in Vandy's win against the University of Louisville Wednesday night. Senior guard Deborah Denton, a longrange bomber, pitches in 17.9 points for Coach Phil Lee's squad.
