Dear Sir & Comrade

I wrote you once

before, when I was thinking of making an appli-
cation for pension I did not hear from you
and did not make an application but I
am now doing so. And want to try &
refresh your memory in regard to myself
my claim is for a disease of stomach con-
tracted while we were laying in camp
near Nashville Tenn. Waiting to be mustered
out. and while there I think it was about
The 27th day of Sep. 1865. I bought some
thing to eat. I think it was stewed chicken
from a woman, who came into camp,
and soon after eating of I was taken
Violently sick at the stomach, and Vomited
and had pains in stomach nearly all after-
noon. And was very weak for the balance
of the time until I reached home.
