incurred Bronchitis and from Camp Chase we went
to Nashville Tenn. and there said R. K. White was sent
to the Hospital on account of said disease and I
never saw him until at Piney Station he came to us
and was still sick. and after a short time he was sent
to the Hospital at Huntsville Ala and from there
he was discharged and sent home on account of
disability and since we were mustered out of service
I have saw him often and he is still complaining
the same way. and from what I know he is a
disabled man. Reclaimant before he went into the
service and never heard him complain of any disease
prior to enlisting in the service. I also know that
at Huntsville Ala he complained of Rheumatism
and often since that has he complained of " "
to me.
