furlough I was sick and could
not Report back to Hospital
No 8. at Nashville and so I
got the Physician which was
then attending on me to
send my furlough to the
A. D. General at Detroit and he
extended it for 20 days longer
The furlough was sent to
Capt John Dyer then acting
Assistant A. A. General. I was
at Home Sick Dec. 31st ¹⁸⁶⁴ and
Feb 28th 1865 and on the 15th
- of April 1865 I reported personally
to the A. D. G. and was then
sent to the St. Marys
Hospital Detroit where I remain
until I receive my discharge
if the Department requires any
further information of me let me
