The corporation proposed to be organized shall be named and known as The Floyd County Overseas Veterans, Inc., by which name it may contract and be contracted with, sue and be sued, adopt a corporate seal and conduct its business.

ARTICLE II.

The principal office and place of business of said corporation shall be in the Town of Lancer, Floyd County, Kentucky.

ARTICLE III

The General nature and purpose of the corporation shall be:-

educational; to preserve and strengthen comradeship among its members; to assist worthy comrades; to perpetuate the memory and history of our dead, and to assist their widows and orphans; to maintain true allegiance to the Government of the United States of America and fidelity to its Constitution and laws; to foster true patriotism; to maintain and extend the Institutions of American Freedom; and to preserve and defend the United States from all her enemies; whomsoever.
