This cause having been submitted for judgment in conformity with the opinion of the Court of Appeals, rendered herein upon hearing, and the court being sufficiently advised, adjudges that plaintiff's petition be dismissed, and that the defendant, Wallace J. Williamson, recover against Mrs. Ann Dills, Executrix of the estate of Col. John Dills, on his Counter-claim, the sum of Two Thousand (\$2000.00) dollars, with interest thereon at 6% per annum from the 27th day of August A.D. 1903, until paid. to be levied of assets of the estate of Col, John Dills in her hands unadministered, together with all of his costs herein expended, for which he may have executin

The Court further adjudges that for the payment of said sum above named the said Wallace J. Williamson has a lien upon the undivided one third interest of Col. John Dills, in and to that certain tract of land, situated in Pike County, Kentucky, on the waters of Tug River and Peter Creek, and tributaries, and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a water birch on Tug river near the mouth of Peter Creek; thence up said river , S. 89 E. 110 poles to a beech opposite Clines barn; S. 52 E. 100 poles to a beech; S. 4 E. 40 poles; S. 7 W. 120 poles to a Sycamore at Dick Mounts; S. 4 30' E. 80 poles to a Walnut on bank of the river; S. 80 30' E. 140 poles to Lick Branch; N. 70 E. 20 poles to a sugar tree; N. 26 E. 100 poles ; N. 30 poles to a stake on a point; N. 41 E. 54 poles; N. 45 E. 34 poles to a mulberry; thence E. 36 poles to a beech; S. 81 E. 20 Poles to a beech; S. 87 30' E. 78 poles to a Paw paw , opposite a steep gut on the virginia side; N. 80 30' E. 60 poles to a beech in a gut; N. 89 E. 46 poles; S. 45 30' E. 50 poles to McMounts; S. 27 E. 116 poles to a beech; S. 81 E. 114 poles; crossing polar cree N. 58 E. 40 poles to a beech; N. 65 E. 34 poles to a birch;
