For its separate answer to the petition of plaintiff herein, the defendant, Millers Creek Contracting Company, denies that on the 15th day of September, 1909, or at other time, it was engaged in hauling sawlogs from land situated on Millers Creek, Pike county, Kentucky, on to and down Cow Pen Creek, Pike county, Kentucky, to Big Sandy River; denies that the method of removing or transporting said sawlogs was down a tramroad constructed by this defendant on which logs were placed and hauled from said Millers creek down Cow Pen creek to Big Sandy river; denies that it constructed any tramroad from Millers creek down Cow Pen creek to Big Sandy river; denies that upon the said tramway trucks were placed by this defendant upon which logs were loaded or transported by gravity, or otherwise, down said Cow Pen creek; and denies that for this purpose, or for any purpose, this defendant had unlawfully, illegally, without right or at all caused the said tramroad to be constructed in an angle, or otherwise constructed, so that when the car started it would run from the head of Cow Pen creek to a branch tributary
