Surveyor Rayne mentions three tracts so we get the three or only the one which you mention in your letter of 4th inst as 416 acres and which we make 353. Whatever it is you may compute the acreage and draw on me for the amount; I suppose it was at the rate of 50¢ per acre, when we see you in Pike you can give us the costs and give you draft for same.
