vs. AGREED ORDER.

Came this day the contestant, A. L. Hill, and produced and filed agreement controverting the affirmative matters of the answer and counter-contest of record. Thereupon came the parties and produced and filed stipulation and agreement waiving and abandoning all grounds of contest and counter-contest herein except such as arises from a re-count of the ballots herein. The contestant and contestee agree to accept as correct the official count of the ballots as certified by the election commissioners of Knott County, Kentucky, to-wit: 526 votes for E. D. Stephenson and 393 votes for A. L. Hill. In Floyd County, Kentucky, the votes of Johns Creek precinct #8 is to be counted as 55 votes for A. L. Hill and 2 votes for E. D. Stephenson. In Antioch precinct in Floyd County, Ky., said votes shall be counted as 109 votes for E. D. Stephenson and 9 votes for A. L. Hill. In Leckieville precinct, Pike County, Ky., shall be counted 104 votes for E. D. Stephenson and none for A. L. Hill. In Island Creek precinct, Pike County, Ky., there shall be counted for E. D. Stephenson 16 votes and for A. L. Hill 3 votes. The ballot boxes in all the other precincts in Floyd and Pike Counties shall be re-opened and the ballots therein in the Senatorial race between contestant and contestee shall be
