MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE BOARD OF BAR COMMISSIONERS OF THE KEN-TUCKY STATE BAR ASSOCIATION, HELD OCTOBER 22, 1948, IN LOUISVILLE, KY. A meeting of the Board of Bar Commissioners was held at the Kentucky Hotel, Louisville, Kentucky. Mr. George Wilson presided and the roll call disclosed the following members present: Mr. Moore Mr. Hatchett Mr. Martin Col. Stites Mr. Cochran Mr. Davis Mr. Harkins Mr. McGregor Mr. Redwine Mr. Scott Mr. Harlin Mr. Duncan and Mr. Gordon could not be present. On motion of Mr. Davis, seconded by Mr. Moore, the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting were dispensed with, in view of the fact that a copy had heretofore been sent each commissioner.

It was reported that the Louisville Bar Association had requested an advisory opinion on the propriety of an attorney soliciting legal employment from a person with whom he had not had a previous relationship. The matter had been referred to Commissioner Cochran for an opinion, and an opinion consisting of 22 pages was presented to the Board for consideration. On motion of Mr. Davis, seconded by Mr. Moore, the report was received and approved, and the Secretary was firected to communicate with Mr. Cochran and ask him to prepare an article for the Bar Journal to be printed as promptly as possible. The Secretary was directed to send a copy of the opinion to Chief Justice of the Court of Appeals. A copy of the advisory opinion is attached hereto as a part hereof.
