This cause being submitted for trial and the Court being sufficiently advised and judges that the Plaintiff William J Mayo recover of the Defendant Solomon Drassett the sum of twenty eight dollars with interest from the 8th day of March 1843 until paid and all his cost herein expended.

It is further adjudged that the Plaintiff William J Mayo have a lien on the following tract of land situated in Alford County on the Bull Creek at the mouth of the Chestnut Creek fork of said Creek bounded as follows. Beginning at a conditional line and corner between John Massey and William Massey on a beech and mulberry which was made by John Massey & William Massey of the fifty acres and two hundred and three acres by survey patented in the name of John Massey on the 28th day of February 1845 examined and recorded in Book 66 page
