Dear Sir:

In the matter of contest of yourself
vs. James Hale for Magistrate in Magisterial
District No. 2, of Floyd County, Kentucky,

First: It is necessary in preparing the
notice and petition of the contest that we have
and insert in it, the names of as many of the
voters as possible whose votes were paid for by
James Hale or any persons working for and on his
behalf.

Second: Of the voters who did not live
in Buckeye Precinct, who were premitted to vote in
such Precinct and who voted in favor of James
Hale.

Third: Of the names of voters who would
have voted in favor of you, who were not permitted
to vote by the election officers or by reason of
the fact that the Ballots were taken away by Pete
Bailey.

Fourth: Of the voters who voted upon the
table and in favor of James Hale, who were not
sworn as to their qualifications.

Fifth: Of the people who were permitted to
come into and remain in the room in which the
election was being held.

Sixth: Of the person under the age of
twenty-one years who voted for James Hale.
