"You get kids that have a history of failure and they read the correct word and the computer turns around and says "nope, that's not right," and they get furious," he said. Hasslebring said the decision to continue his research at UK was an easy one, describing the work in technology within the special education department over the past twenty years as "top shelf."

"It's my goal to take that to the next level so that when people think about technology and special education they'll only think of one place, and that's UK, he said. do that what I see us building are world class reasons.

"I think the vice president had to say to himself, 'Hey. I need to go out and tell my story, 'People don't know anything about me," Mrs. Clinton told The Associated Press in an interview. "I learned the same thing."

#### Croatia elects Mesic president

ZAGREB, Croatia — A former member of a Yugoslavia's collective presidency won Croatia's presidential election yesterday when his opponent conceded, hours before the first results were to be announced. Stipe Mesic was the victor in the runoff to succeed the late Franjo Tudjman. Early, unofficial results showed Mesic with a 10 percent lead over Drazen Budisa.
