

Sunday morning (27 Oct. 1826)

Here is, my dear Allyn, a letter from your excellent Charming Lady whom we already love on her own account with all our hearts.

Enclose a packet for one of your papouges, M^r. Bironi, an Italian painter, who has been recommended to me.

Madam De Laubespin and her father will have fully spoken to you of young Victor Lacqueront, son to my intimate friend, a very interesting young man, whom I recommend to your kindness and to your introduction to our friends. Le Vasseur joins a letter to M^r. Peugnet.

Besides this packet I have made one for M^r. Clay which I beg you to forward.

George has undertaken to put up all these dispatches with his own for you, so that I leave it to his care; M^r. H. will send a few more letters by this day's post, which going from Paris Monday must I think reach M^r. Smith (Phillippon's house) before you sail.
