The voters of Kentucky have registered a decision at the polls which will seriously affect the future progress of the University for several years to come. When the ballots had been counted last veck it was found that the electorate had resoundingly voted down an amendment to the state constitution calling for the abolition of a \$5,000 ciling on salaries of state employees.

The passage of the amendment would have enabled the state to increase the salary checks of University personnel to the point where capabile men could be attracted here and men already on the staff could not be so easily entired away by other institutions offering salaries more in keeping with their capabilities.

As the caption on a Courier-Journal cartoon so aptly puts it: \$5,000 is "Mighty Poor Bait for Big Fish." In the past many University attainments, after years of work at meager salaries, have heeded the çall of other schools which were willing to pay them for their ability and experience on a value basis. Who could blame such men for desiring the social and material advantages which a salary that they deserved, not a salary set by an arbitrary statute, could bring them?
