

MRS. CORA WILSON STEWART.

Educator, President Kentucky Illiteracy Commission.

Born at Farmers, Kentucky, January 17, 1875; daughter of Dr. Jeremiah and Annie E. (Halley) Wilson. Educated at Morehead Normal School, Kentucky State University, National Normal University. Former superintendent of Rowan county schools, editor of "The Mountaineer" and president of the Kentucky Educational Association in 1912; now president of the Kentucky Illiteracy Commission. Originator of plan to eradicate illiteracy completely from county, State and nation; founder of Moonlight Schools; author of Country Life Readers; member (1915-1916) State Board Federation of Women's Clubs; member Morehead Woman's Club, Kentucky Educational Association, National Educational Association, and honorary member Frankfort Women's Club.
