# 1988-89 Lady Kats Basketball FRITUGE

KENTUCKY (2-2) VS. DAYTON (0-3)

Tuesday, December 6, 1988 Memorial Coliseum, Lexington, Ky., 7:30 p.m.

The University of Kentucky Lady Kats basketball team, now 2-2 after a disappointing loss to Ohio University, will look for its third win of the season tonight against the Lady Flyers of the University of Dayton.

The Lady Flyers (0-3) are led by 5-10 All-Conference forward Tobette Pleasant. In addition to receiving a unanimous selection to the All-North Star Conference team, Pleasant has been selected Lady Flyer MVP and best defensive player twice in her collegiate career. The Lady Flyers played Morehead State Saturday in Dayton and suffered their third consecutive loss of the season by a

score of 68-60. The Flyers opened their season with the University of Colorado in the Colorado-Coors Invitational, in which Colorado beat the Lady Flyers 86-53. They then faced Michigan State in the tournament and suffered their second loss by a score of 80-56.


Pleasant and the Lady Flyers will try to halt the offensive scoring of Lady Kat guard Jodie Whitaker. Whitaker, who was held to nine points in the OU game, will look for a return to the type of play that earned her a Most Valuable Player title in the season-opening LKIT. She leads the squad with a 16.5 scoring average but is shooting only 41.3 percent. The Lady Kats will also rely on the continued good play of senior forward Pam Shrum (13.5 ppg, 5.3 rpg), who scored a team-high 19 points for Kentucky against Ohio. Junior

center Vanessa Foster-Sutton leads the squad in rebounding at 8.3, and is fourth in scoring at 11.5. The other Kats' double-figure scorer is freshman guard Cushenberry, who has hit 53 percent from the field and 80 percent from the line for a 12.5 average. UK leads the series with Dayton 12-2, but UD took the most recent contest by upsetting the Lady
