Preparation, patience needed for Add/Drop

The chore of having to go through Add/Drop, which begins tomorrow for UK students preparing for the spring 1991 semester, may not be any easier this time. But one official believes it is getting better.

Lisa Collins, UK's director of registration, says students can make it a painless process if they arm themselves with a No. 2 pencil, a knowledge of their spring schedule and, most importantly, patience.

Wednesday marks the opening day of classes for most UK students.

Add/Drop Times

Jan. 8 Add/Drop: 8 a.m. to noon and 1 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the central site (all other sites close at 6 p.m.).
Jan. 9 and 10 Add/Drop: 8 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and 1:30 to 6:00 p.m.
Jan. 11 and Jan. 15: 8 a.m. to

12:30 p.m. to 1:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. Add/Drop locations close from 12:30 to 1:30 p.m. daily.

Who goes first

On Jan. 8, graduate students and seniors can go through Add/Drop from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m.; freshmen can Add/Drop from 10 a.m. to noon; juniors can Add/Drop from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m.; sophomores can Add/Drop from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m.; non-degree students can Add/Drop from 5 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Add/Drop continues, on a first-come, first-serve basis, from Jan. 9 to Jan. 15, Collins said. Students may Add/Drop after their scheduled time but not before.

Where to go

The Add/Drop location is determined by the college in which the student is enrolled. Students report to Add/Drop at the same location

where they advanced registered last semester.

There are some changes, however.

Students in Arts & Sciences, Business & Economics, Communications and some in the graduate school will enter the front entrance of the Whitehall Classroom Building.

Instant service

Those who wish only to drop a class just need to enter Classroom Building 106 to do so. "Instant service and you're out," Collins said.

Students and staff members will direct students to the appropriate lines. Then they'll be directed to a table, where six terminals will be set up. Each student will be asked for his/her Social Security number.

At that point, Collins said, students will be notified if there are any "stops" — unpaid library fines or parking tickets, for example —

which could prevent them from Add/Dropping.

Students also will get a pink card there, letting Add/Drop organizers know "they've done everything they need to do" at that point, Collins said.

Then the process of getting the schedule computerized and OK'd — and the long waiting in lines — begins.

One change definitely should please students, Collins said. UK has improved the organization of Add/Drop so students won't have to stand outside while waiting in line.

Collins said the Classroom Building will be used for the overflow.

How long it will take

Collins said following a few tips will make it seem easier and probably shorter: Be at your Add/Drop site about 30 minutes ahead of your scheduled time; carry with you a No. 2 pencil; have a "good, solid idea" of what classes you want; bring a schedule book and a copy of this edition of the Kernel.

Also, remember to have alternate courses in the event that a class is closed.

Last fall, no down time was reported with computers, which meant that Add/Drop went as smoothly as possible. "I don't promise it'll be any easier," she said. But if students arrive on time and if there is good system support and good weather, "then Add/Drop will be a success."

How many are expected

Collins said between 1,800 and 2,000 students are expected at the Classroom Building tomorrow. But, she added, "we don't know what's going to happen so we're preparing for the largest crowd."

Cats grab nation's attention

Oh, the holidays. Heading into the Christmas break, folks around college basketball didn't really know what to make of the 1990-91 University of Kentucky Wildcat basketball team.

Now they do.

A lot of people thought the Cats — who had not exactly played the toughest pre-Christmas break schedule — would crumble when facing the likes of North Carolina, Indiana, Louisville and Georgia on the road.

ANALYSIS

I mean, before the break, UK hadn't exactly shown that it was a Top 25 club because its early season victims (Cincinnati, Kansas, Notre Dame) each struggled.

Now UK has won respect from all — even Indiana coach Bob Knight, a long-time UK basher.

Check the box scores. UK only beat U of I by eight points (93-85) but the Cats whipped the Cards. And UK came within three points of both Indiana and Carolina on the road. Only late-game breakdowns kept the Cats from being undefeated. And last Wednesday, they went to Georgia and stunned the Dawgs 81-80 in Athens.

Perhaps the most stunning thing about the holidays was not the white Christmas or the Cats' sparkling 9-2 record heading into last Saturday's LSU game — or their No. 16 ranking in The Associated Press poll. It was Knight's comments after the UK-Indiana game.

He talked about UK's improvement off the court, not on.

"I like Pitino's approach to things. I like the way he coaches. I like the way he has recruited. I like the way he runs things, at least as I have known them," Knight said after UK's close game with IU.

Indiana has long been a hot-bed for rumors about possible wrongdoing in the UK program, but Knight said he doesn't hear much any more.

"I don't hear the things I have heard about Kentucky for 20 years," he said. "I really hope Pitino will develop the program they should have instead of the ... bullshit they had for so many years."

Knight did remind reporters at the postgame news conference that he

1991 marks paper's 20th year of independence

"It is easy to forget when an operation runs fairly well and the money comes in that there were years of exceedingly long hours; little help and support; no money to start the corporation; no cash flow of any amount for five years; and sheer determination of a small number to assure its survival."

Nancy Green, the independent Kernel's first adviser, wrote those words about this time 10 years ago. She was talking about the same newspaper you hold in your hands, the Kentucky Kernel. And her words are as true in 1991 as they were in 1981.

This year we will celebrate our 20th anniversary as the independent student newspaper of the University of Kentucky. Infancy wasn't easy (we had angry parents); childhood was tough; adolescence had its share of turmoil; and, hey, adulthood ain't no picnic, either. Not when you're staring a recession in the face.

But, hey, doesn't every Sam, Dick and Harriet celebrate birthdays? We are, after all, a statistical society. The 20th this. The 100th that. Allow me to digress a little bit because this celebration is an especially special one.

The Kernel, after all, is the only college newspaper thrust into independence in the early 1970s that really made it from scratch. The others — like Florida's Independent Alligator — already had all of the things the Kernel had to create, like bookkeeping departments, advertising departments and solid revenues that would support the publication without University funds.

As Green wrote, the Kernel had nothing at the beginning, and now it is a viable corporation as modern as any small commercial newspaper its size in the nation. As of 1988, in fact, we were the fourth largest morning daily in the state and the only college paper in the state that publishes five days a week.

When I look back at old Kernels, I try to imagine what the college experience was like for the students who worked on the paper while going to school. They probably missed a lot of classes, stayed up in the wee hours of the morning sitting bleary-eyed at terminals, kept the soft drink companies in business and read defenses (i.e. tossing a football when they should have been reading copy.

The independent Kernel's first editor, Michael Wines, whose early efforts paved the way toward success, was asked what he would remember most about his two-year term as editor. He replied, "the pain, rather than the pleasure."

But that's what makes this business so rewarding and so enjoyable. And that's why we will be celebrating the independent Kernel's 20th anniversary this year.

When you examine events in 1971, it's not too hard to figure why the Kernel went independent. Students, especially student reporters, were much more militant and radical then than they are now. And much more inclined to cause change.

And it was a group of students from a competing student newspaper, The Wildcat, which brought about change. Upset with the Kernel's decision to run 95 percent of

its news hole with wire copy from The Associated Press and the remaining part with liberally tainted writing, Wildcat staffers demanded that it, too, receive funding from the UK Board of Trustees.

At that time, the University was providing a subsidy of about 55 percent of the Kernel's operating funds. The Board voted in April of 1971 to end that funding — about \$45,000 per year. And on Jan. 19, 1972, the Kernel was on its own.

Not everybody was happy about it. One A. B. "Happy" Chandler, a board member who was a frequent target of critical Kernel editorials, was heard to say: "This is only manslaughter. I wanted murder."

Chandler came back a decade later and, while ripping a Kernel in half, reportedly said, "This isn't required reading."

For some 23,000 students plus hundreds of faculty members, staff and administrators, however, it is required reading. Some can't afford to subscribe to other newspapers, getting their only source of print news from the Kernel. That's a fact we don't take lightly.

Being independent means we are entirely student-run. From the ac-

count executives in our advertising department who determine our paper size to the staffers who scoop up news to fill the hole to the production people who wax 'n' paste, the Kernel exists because students exist. The only exceptions to that rule are our wonderful secretary, business manager, production manager and aggressive student publications adviser, all without whom the Kernel couldn't survive.

Being independent doesn't mean anything unless you use it. It's like the First Amendment — just a piece of paper, until you need it.

That's why we can call for a class walkout or a new presidential search, why we can criticize the Board of Trustees and publish comic strips like the "Doggy Bag" without fear of reprisal or censorship.

I wouldn't be the first editor to admit that responsibility brings with it little sleep, but hey, I knew that coming in. Every editor does. Young Mr. Wines was right. This job can be a pain. But boy, does it hurt so good.

STUDENTS PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

RE: Change to University Senate Rules Regarding AUDIT

In November, the University Senate amended the Senate Rules pertaining to the requirements of students who audit courses. This change is effective Spring Semester 1991. The addition to the rule reads as follows:

A student who initially enrolls in a class as an auditor must attend at least 80 percent of the classes in the course (excluding excused absences). If a student changes her or his enrollment from credit to audit, s/he must attend at least 80 percent of the remaining classes (excluding excused absences). If an auditor fails to attend the requisite number of classes, the instructor may award a grade of W for that course.

had said the same things about Eddie Sutton when he took over.

"I hope I'm not wrong this time. I hope this is an era we can enjoy playing Kentucky because they're planning to do things the way they ought to be. I hope that, either win or lose, I can walk off the floor and respect the people that we're playing against and respect the kind of operation Kentucky has," Knight said.

Those comments caught every media member in the room off guard. Nobody was expecting this. Here we were looking for quotes about the Hoosiers' 87-84 win, and Knight gives his unprovoked testimony about the UK program.

Wow.

Knight is right on the mark with his comments. But, then again, he could not have been further off than he was when gave similar praise to "Fast Eddie" Sutton four years ago.

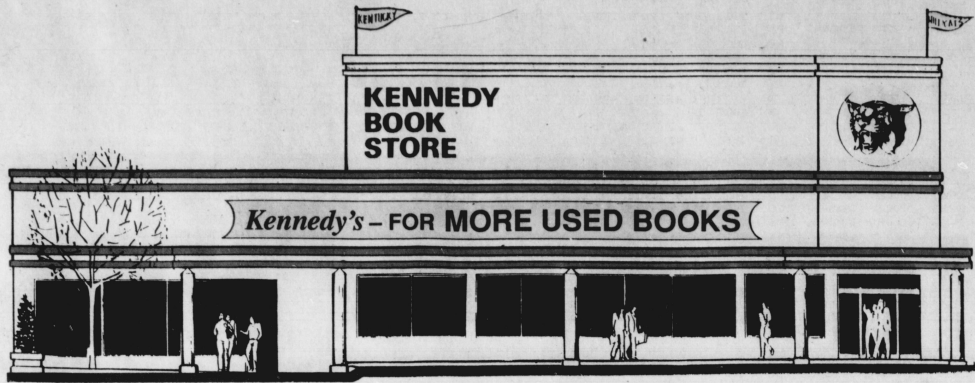
