

Ledgerwood Mills  
 In 1811 Col. Joseph Ledgerwood owned the Ledgerwood Mills and 100 acres of land purchased at his father James Ledgerwood's sale who died in 1806 - 26 Decr - also 100 acres known as the Cartwright farm near Carlisle devised to him by his father's will - Joseph died in 1811 - Julia Ann 12 months - The James Sproule married the widow Ledgerwood (Nancy) - she being entitled to dower - she had one child by Joseph Ledgerwood Julia Ann Ledgerwood - who married Joseph C. McDouall - she died in 1852 - ~~Wm Allen~~ Bright claimed to have bought the ~~land~~ <sup>second</sup> 100 acres of Ledgerwood before his death - William Ledgerwood as admr. gave a Bond for a deed to Bright <sup>upon</sup> ~~that~~ Julia Ann ~~at~~ became of age - Bright took possession under the Bond - the land has been transferred several times since - but no deed has ever been taken for the land from Ledgerwood's heirs -
