**Dan's Greatest Mile.** All Lexington, Ky., on Oct. 13, 1895, Dan Patch Paced the Greatest Mile of His Life. First quarter in 29 seconds, second quarter in 27 $\frac{1}{2}$  seconds, (a 1:00 clip)—to the half in 56 $\frac{1}{2}$  seconds (a 1:03 clip)—at the three quarters in 1:28 $\frac{1}{2}$ . At the seven-eighths pole his nose water broke a blood vessel in his nostril and instantly choked his speed. This accident has to be toward the horse and converted him to shaker his tremendous ability as he was halting strong and full of speed. In spite of this he finished the mile in 1:58 $\frac{1}{2}$ . All his records between all knowledge that this excellent pacer set a mile in 1:54 and was his Finest Mile. Dan Patch, Frank Joss, 1891—above mile figured in 1902.
