DISEASE

Public health costs are so high in the bad housing districts of Manhattan and Brooklyn that 39 percent of these areas fail to pay for even half of the services they receive. FIRE



In the bad housing areas of Cleveland, Ohio, the cost of fire protection is \$58 per family. In the suburbs it is only \$50 per family.

CRIME



juvenile delinquents in Chicago come from 6 percent of the city's area. Expenditures on account of felonies were more than \$8 per capita in one census tract in the Indianapolis slums. The average per capita cost for the city was only 60 cents.
