

The Satellite Town

• In all the region it would be difficult to find a better location for a satellite town than the greenbelt community site. The town has been placed to avoid heavy streams of traffic, and yet to lie between two major highways. Two big employment centers, Washington and Baltimore, are within easy commuting distance; while about 400 jobs will be available in the nearby National Agricultural Research Center. The town itself lies on a partially wooded crescent of land, rising about 200 feet above sea level. A protective strip of garden, park, and forest land covers the ravines and valleys on all sides of the plateau.
