Supplement to the Fall Schedule of Classes

Changes put 'fun' into ADD/DROP

Those good old, bad old days of ADD/DROP are back again.

If you haven't registered yet, don't try to go through centralized ADD/DROP tomorrow because it is for pre-registered students only. An IBM ADD/DROP Permit Card is reserved for each pre-registered student, and will be given to them after they enter Memorial Coliseum, where ADD/DROP is held.

Jerry Legere, associate registrar for student records, is coordinating ADD/DROP this year rather than George Dexter, associate registrar for registration. The switch came after people in the registrar's office decided ADD/DROP involves the records department more than registration. "I tried to have fun planning ADD/DROP," Legere said, adding that he hopes the changes he made will help students enjoy ADD/DROP this year. The new instruction sheet has cartoons illustrating the process, and concession stands on the Coliseum's concourses will sell hamburgers, hotdogs, popcorn and cokes.

Also on the more table, for ADD/DROP computer card pick up, has been moved onto the Coliseum floor. The *business and economics* college's table joins the *history English* tables on the Coliseum floor so that congestion in the concourses will lessen.

Legere said there are a few steps students should take before attending ADD/DROP. They are:

— Know which classes you are enrolled in according to your class schedule or bring a copy of your schedule.

— Bring a copy of the Fall Schedule of Classes or the Supplement to the Fall Schedule of Classes (you are reading one now.)

— Bring a No. 2 lead pencil. Legere said students should come to centralized ADD/DROP at their appointed time; the schedule is set and there are almost no exceptions. However, if you want to be at the head of your line entering the Coliseum, you should come a few minutes early.

After entering the Coliseum at your scheduled time, pick up your IBM ADD/DROP Permit Card, the new yellow instruction sheet and an ADD/DROP slip if you do not have one already.

The ADD/DROP slips are new this year too. There is room on each slip to drop and add seven courses, and on the back of your copy of the slip there

are instructions for dropping and adding courses.

After deciding which classes you are dropping and adding, you should pick up the computer class cards at the department and college tables on the concourses and on the Coliseum's floor. Consult the map on the back of your instruction sheet for the location of tables you need to visit.

Each transaction requires a computer card; to change sections in a class, you need one card to drop the section you are in and one to add the section you need. However, only one ADD/DROP slip is needed.

Each computer card must be filled out with a No. 2 lead pencil. Students must write their social security number in area one of the card and the transaction in area two.

Areas three and four on the computer card are related to certain types of transactions and are not filled in all cases.

There are four transactions you can make during ADD/DROP. Besides adding and dropping courses, you can change the number of hours you take in courses where the credit hours vary. And, you can change your grade option to letter grade, pass/fail or audit.

After filling out your ADD/DROP slip and computer cards you should return them to YOUR Dean's table, that is the Dean of the college in which you are enrolled. Consult the map on the back of the instructions again for the table's location.

Legere said it is important to fill out all cards and slips completely and correctly. There were between 12,000 and 13,000 transactions during last semester's ADD/DROP, and his office expects a similar number this semester, he said.

Approximately 10 percent of the transactions made during ADD/DROP last semester contained errors according to Legere, many of the errors occurred when students wrote the wrong social security number on their computer cards.

If the computer cards are filled out completely, many mistakes can be corrected in the Student Records office by checking the student's past records, but this can be done only if the student's name has been filled in the hand written space supplied on the card.

It is important for students to keep their copies of ADD/DROP slips, Legere said, because they can become very important if you need to verify a transaction later, which sometimes happens.

In the Student Center's Grand Ballroom Long lines are forming for financial aid . . .

The Grand Ballroom in the Student Center is the place to go to pick up financial aid checks, but if you don't like standing in long lines you should wait until at least Wednesday to visit the financial aid desk.

"The lines are very long on Monday and Tuesday," said Dave Prater, student loan coordinator. "But later in the week you can walk right up to the desk, instead of waiting in line."

If you were notified that you will receive financial aid, you should go to the Student Center Ballroom this week.

Representatives from Billings and Collection, Financial Aid and Food Services will be in the Grand Ballroom from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday through Friday. After Friday, the representatives will return to their offices.

And, students who haven't been notified about whether they will receive financial aid—including those who applied late—or, if they still need to apply they should wait until the third week in September to come to the financial aid office, Prater said.

Although he did not have any figures, he said there will be an additional amount of financial aid available to applicants this year. "We want to encourage students to come see us (in the financial aid office) during the third week of September," he said.

If a student's tuition is being paid by a third party—this includes band students, athletes and foreign students—Prater said they should get in the grant-in-aid line in the Ballroom, which reads, "Third party billing," or "Billing and Collection."

Prater said students with fellowships and teaching assistant-

ships should stand in this line also.

Students who applied for and have been hired for the work-study program should go to the 5th floor of Patterson Office Tower and talk to Bobby Halsey, assistant director of student financial aid, to get their job

assignment.

And, students applying for financial aid need to remember, Prater said, that the University does not have short-term loans for tuition, so students must pay this fee on their own.

. . . tuition payments, UK IDs, parking permits, health fees . . .

After moving your possessions home for the summer and then back to your dorm room or apartment, it's probable that something you need—your meal card, UK ID or tuition payment card—has disappeared.

Where do you go to replace these lost items?

If you lost your UK ID or you want your picture retaken, UK's Photographic Services will develop a new ID for \$5. "During the week of payment, we'll be set up there (Student Center Ballroom) and we can make it (the ID) there," said John Mitchell, manager of photographic services.

Mitchell said students should bring some proof of identification with them; either a driver's license with the student's picture on it or two pieces of identification. "If it's a lost ID and has been validated," Mitchell said,

representatives from Photographic Services can place a validation sticker on it when the student has the picture taken. And, new students should have their free ID made before Sept. 12, or they will be charged \$5.

After Friday, students can go to 0005 Kastle Hall, where Photographic Services is located, to have new IDs made. Pictures will be taken on Monday afternoons between 1:15 and 4:15 p.m. and Thursday mornings between 8:15 and 11:45 a.m.

If you lose your meal card, you should go to the Food Storage office, located on Donovan Drive behind K-Lair grill. The office is open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., and students will be issued a temporary meal card while the permanent card is developed.

There is a \$5 charge to replace the meal card the first time you lose it, and a \$10 charge the second time.

If you still need to pay fees, the

Student Center Ballroom will have tables set up from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. this week.

Tuition payments can be made in the Ballroom this week and in the Billings and Collections office, 220 Service Building, until Sept. 12 at 3:30 p.m.

If you don't pay the fee before Sept. 12, you're stuck with a \$50 reinstatement fee plus your tuition fee. Your last chance to pay the tuition and reinstatement fees ends Sept. 21, at 3:30 p.m.

Students who withdraw from school during the first week of classes are liable for 20 percent of the tuition bill; if they withdraw before Oct. 22, they must pay 50 percent of their tuition fees.

If students want to pay the \$18 Student Health fee, they can drop by the table set up at the foot of the steps leading to the Ballroom. After Friday, students can pay the health fee at the Billings and Collections office until the Sept. 21 deadline.

A table for Blue Cross Blue Shield will also be set up in the Ballroom; students can sign up for the student hospitalization program and pay their premiums at the same time.

Student parking permits will be issued tomorrow in the Student Center to full-time junior, senior and graduate students on a first come basis. Freshman and sophomores are not eligible for parking permits and must park their cars in the Commonwealth Stadium parking lot.

"C" permits will be issued from 9 a.m. to noon, and from 1:30 to 4 p.m. today. "R" permits and remaining "C" permits will be issued Wednesday and Thursday from 8:30 a.m. to noon, and from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.

Parking permits will also be issued Friday, from 8:30 a.m. to noon, and from 1 p.m. to 2:45 p.m.

If you're living off-campus and you'd like to select a telephone in a specific style and color,

representatives from General Telephone will be at the Student Center Aug. 22 through Sept. 7.

Dorothy Schremser, director of GTE's public affairs department, said students can save money by selecting their telephone and taking it home; it costs around \$10 for someone from the phone company to deliver the phone and plug it in.

To select a phone, students should go to Room 113 between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

Students can also apply for a student billing number during these hours in 111 Student Center. There is no charge to set up the billing account, but students should have bring credit information if they've had a personal phone before to show they paid their bills on time, Schremser said.

Representatives from the Lexington *Herald-Leader* and Louisville *Courier Journal*

newspapers will be at the Student Center, Kennedy's Bookstore and Memorial Coliseum during ADD/DROP to sell subscriptions this week.

Students and faculty who subscribe to the *Herald-Leader* will receive their newspaper beginning Sept. 1. The papers will be delivered through Dec. 16, with no deliveries made during Thanksgiving Break.

Subscribers will pay for 12 of the 14 weeks and receive a daily and Sunday issue of the paper for \$14.95, reduced from the regular subscription price of \$17.64.

Subscribers to the *Courier Journal* will receive the first two weeks free, and will be charged the regular price—80 cents per week for the daily issue, 55 cents for each Sunday issue—rather than a student discount rate.

The *Courier Journal* will not be delivered Labor Day and during Thanksgiving Break.

Students will receive more cash with new tuition refund policy

UK Students who withdraw from the University between Aug. 27 and Sept. 5 will receive an 80 percent tuition refund this year — if they have paid their tuition — under the Board of Trustees' new refund policy, approved Jan. 30.

Or, if students have not paid their tuition fees, they will pay 20 percent of the bill when they withdraw from their classes.

Under the old policy, approved Sept. 18, 1973, students who withdrew from the University between the first day of class and the midterm received a 50 percent tuition refund.

Jerry Legere, associate registrar for student records, said the new policy is aimed at reducing the number of no-show students in over-requested courses. The policy benefits students who withdraw early enough to free "critical class spaces" for students who want to add the course, he said.

Under both policies, students who withdraw from classes between Sept. 6 and Oct. 22, at midterm, are entitled to a 50 percent refund, Legere said. After Oct.

22, they receive no refund.

If students change their status from full- to part-time after going through ADD/DROP, they have a longer period to claim refunds under this policy, Legere said. Under the old policy, "Students had to come into the office and request a refund prior to the deadline date," he said. Under the new policy, "A student has one year from the date they drop to request a refund."

A word to the wise: "Refunds are not automatic," Legere said. "They have to come in and tell us (about them)." If students need their fees reassessed, or if they are entitled to a refund after going through centralized ADD/DROP, they can go directly to the Registrar's table in the Student Center Ballroom. Students should bring their ADD/DROP slip, and they will be able to pay their fees there also, Legere said.

The student records office also has part-time student ID validation stickers for students who change their status from full- to part-time. Students don't have to send their IDs to Billings and Collections anymore, Legere said. Now, validation stickers can be changed in the student records office when students come in to claim their tuition refunds.

Sept. 5 — Last day to enter an organized class. Last day to withdraw and receive an 80 percent tuition refund.

Sept. 12 — Last day to pay registration fees to avoid cancellation of your registration. Pay in Billings and Collections office, 220 Service Building. Last day for new students to pick up ID cards from Billings and Collections without paying replacement

fee.

Sept. 21 — Last day for reinstatement of students cancelled for not paying registration fees. Students must pay registration fee plus the \$50 reinstatement fee. Last day to pay Student Health fee for fall semester.

Sept. 27 — Last day to file for December degree in College Dean's Office.
Oct. 3 — Last day to change grading option from pass-fail to credit or credit to pass-fail;

credit to audit or audit to credit. Last day to drop a course with no indication of course on transcript record.

Oct. 22 — Last day to drop a course. Last day to withdraw from the University or reduce schedule and receive any refund. Request refunds through Student Records office, 107 Gillis Building.
