Referring to your recent inquiry as to present status of suits affecting Mason & Hurst, I herewith enclose copy of a letter of the 4th instant, written me by Wootton & Morgan in reference to this matter.

In view of the statement in the letter from Wootton & Morgan that there has been no change in these cases and that the funds due Mason & Hurst will have to be held until these cases are disposed of, I think it inadvisable, for the present, to pay over to Mason & Hurst any part of the funds retained by the Company as protection against these claims.
