

This Indenture made this 3rd day of November, 1905 between Bettie S. Goff and John Goff, her husband, of Clark County, Kentucky, party of the first part, and Lee Campbell and Belle Campbell, his wife, of Breathitt County, Kentucky, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That ~~for~~ in consideration of the sum of \$650.00 cash in hand paid and the further sum of \$50.00 to be paid 12 months from date, as evidenced by note of this date, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties of the first part have bargained and sold, and each hereby give, grant and convey unto the party of the second part, their heirs and assigns the following described land, situate, lying and being in the county of Breathitt and State of Kentucky, and on the North Fork of the Kentucky River and bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at two elm trees standing on the North Bank of said river about 120 yards below the mouth of the first drain that runs through the bottom above the Lick Shoal and corner to a tract of land deeded by John D. Strong and wife to Alfred C. Strong, on May 14th, 1892; thence across said bottom with the lines of said Strong's deed, N 35 E 31 poles to a forked apple tree, N 8 3/4 E 2 poles and 21 links to a stone, and thence crossing the garden and running between the house and the upper side of the lower house, N 58 3/4 W 5 poles and 24 links to opposite the edge of the porch to the upper house, thence 31 3/4 E 23 links to the middle part of said porch; thence down through the orchard N 54 W 8 poles to a stone, N 34 1/2 E 4 poles to a stone; thence S 87 1/2 E 13 poles passing through the barn to a stone at the branch; thence up the branch N 13 1/2 E 25 3/4 poles to a cedar, N 33 E 14 poles to the end
