Dear Sir:

Replying to yours of the 23rd inst., in reference to Carter Wilder, a section laborer injured at Neon, Ky., February 27, 1915, upon the information contained in your letter, supplemented by information over the telephone this day received from Mr. Butler, I am of opinion that you can safely adjust the matter mentioned with Carter Wilder, by paying him \$4.00 in settlement. So far as his father is concerned, I am confident that you are fully protected by the releases heretofore executed by his father. The only chance for up-setting settlement would, I think, arise from the mere fact that the claimant is under 21 years of age, but I do not anticipate that there will be any trouble on that score.
