Gentlemen:-

Yours of the 6th instant with enclosed copy of Judgment of the Perry Quarterly Court in the case of William Little v. Charlie Osbourne, in which the L. & E. Railway Company was served as garnishee, has been received. The total amount due to be paid by the Railway Company is not perfectly clear from your letter or from the Judgment, but, as I have figured it out, it stands as follows -
