Replying to yours of 15th instant in regard to claim of Mr. Davis for injury to his mare by running into bridge at Kinross, on June 10th.

From papers I have in this case, I see no liability whatever but would suggest that you hold Mr. Davis off until I can have a talk with the engineer (who is now on the extension.) I will then take the matter up with Judge Wilson and one or the other of us will advise you.
