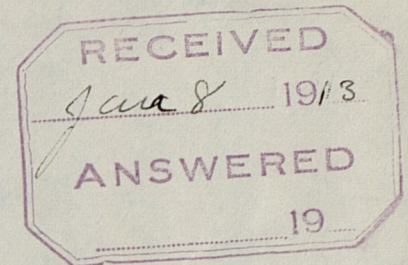

Dear Sir:

One thousand dollars was paid in settlement of a suit filed in the Perry Circuit Court by one Sellers against the L. & E. R'y. I worked out this settlement so that it was actually paid by the Trustee in Bankruptcy of the Jones-Davis Company but we are interested in its recovery from the insurance company.

In order to prepare this suit it is necessary that the attorney for the trustee of the Jones-Davis Company should have specific information relative to this matter. I think you have the file and I will be glad if you advise me what it shows with reference to the <sup>(1)</sup> date of the accident, the <sup>(2)</sup> date of our notification to the Casualty Company of America, the <sup>(3)</sup> style of the suit and a <sup>(4)</sup> copy of the petition if that is in the file. If you haven't this file please send this letter to Mr. B. R. Jouett at Winchester and have him search the files over for it.
